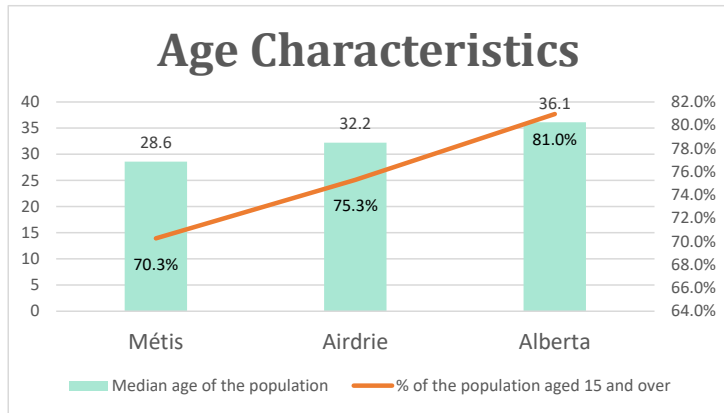


# Airdrie, AB

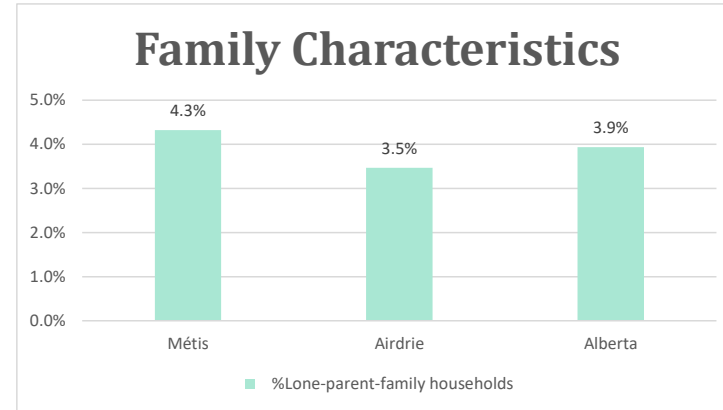

The total population reported with Métis single identity is 925 (Total Métis household is 480), representing 58% of Aboriginal people, accounting for 2.2% of the total population in Airdrie.

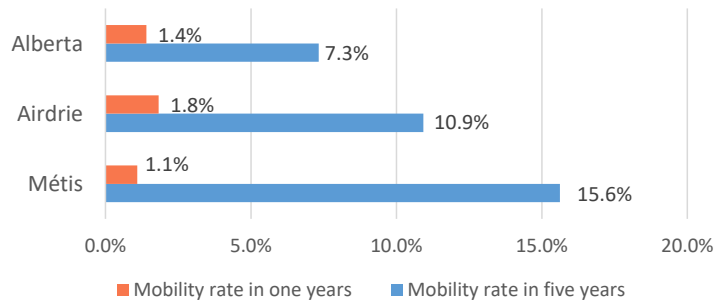


For Métis single identity population, the median age is 28.6 years old, with 70.3% of the population aged 15 and over. As for the total population, the median age is 32.2 in Airdrie and 36.1 years old in Alberta, with 75.3% and 81.0% population aged 15 and over respectively.



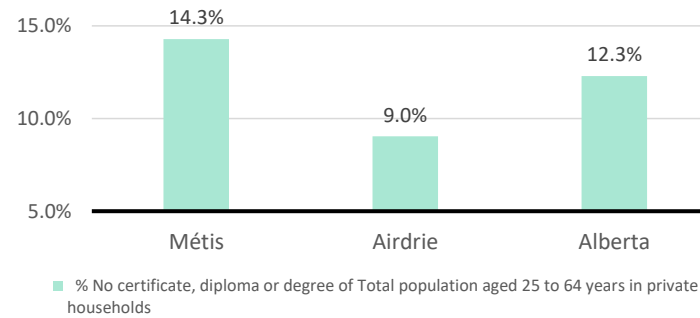
The number of Métis single lone parents household is 40, accounting for 4.3% of the total Métis single private households.

10 Métis households moved in last year (1.1%), 125 Métis households moved in the past 5 years (15.6%).

## Education



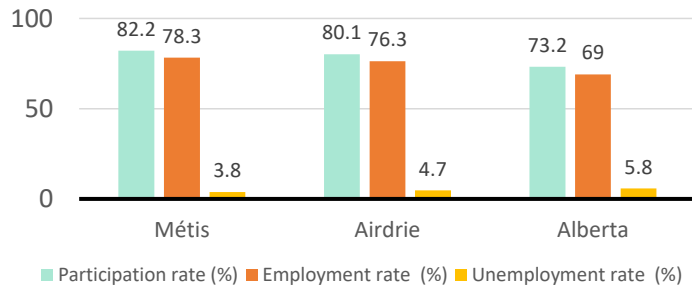
For population aged from 25 to 64 years, 14.3% Métis compared to 9.0% in Airdrie and 12.3% in Alberta have no certificate, diploma or degree.

For Métis aged from 25 to 34, 19.0% Métis reported to have no certificate, diploma or degree.

## Labor Force & Housing Statistics

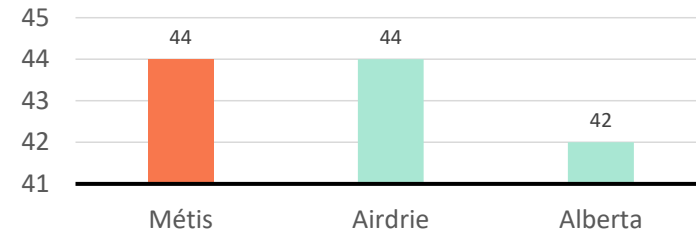
### Labour Force Status



Métis participation rate is 82.2%, employment rate is 78.3%, and unemployment rate is 3.8%.

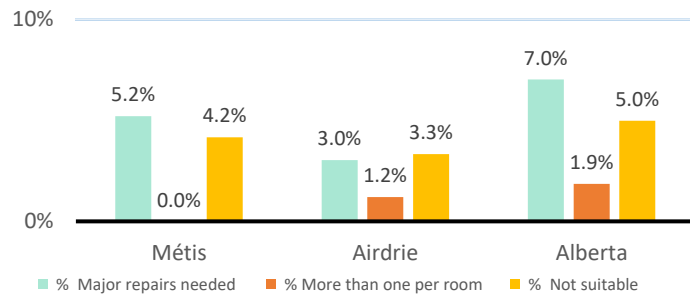
While the participation rate is higher compared with total population in Airdrie and Alberta (80.1% and 73.2%), unemployment rate is lower.

### Average Weeks Worked in 2010



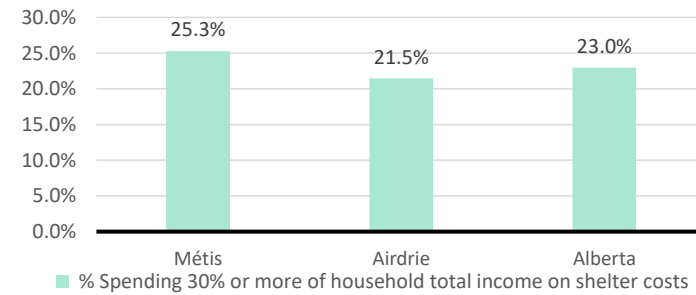
The average weeks worked in 2010 is 44.0 weeks.

### Household Characteristics



There are 480 private dwellings occupied by a Métis single household, out of which 5.2% need major repairs, no Métis household reported have more than one person per room, and 4.2% Métis household reported to be not suitable.

### Shelter Costs



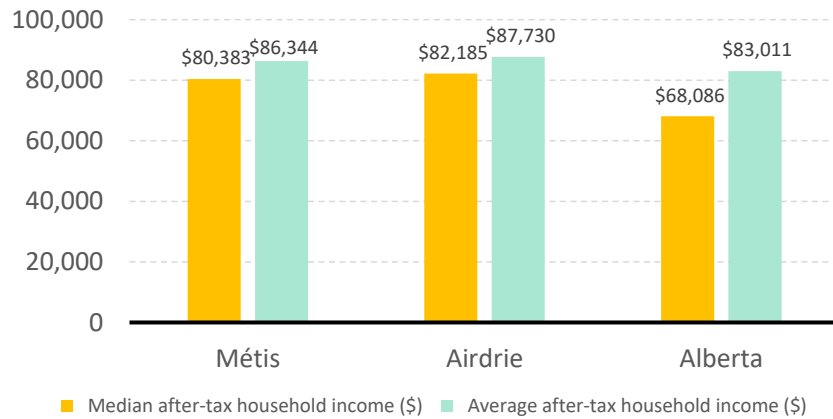
The number of Métis households spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs is 120, which is 25.3%

of the total private dwellings occupied by a Métis household, compared to 21.5% of the total population in Airdrie and 23.0% of the total population in Alberta.

## Income

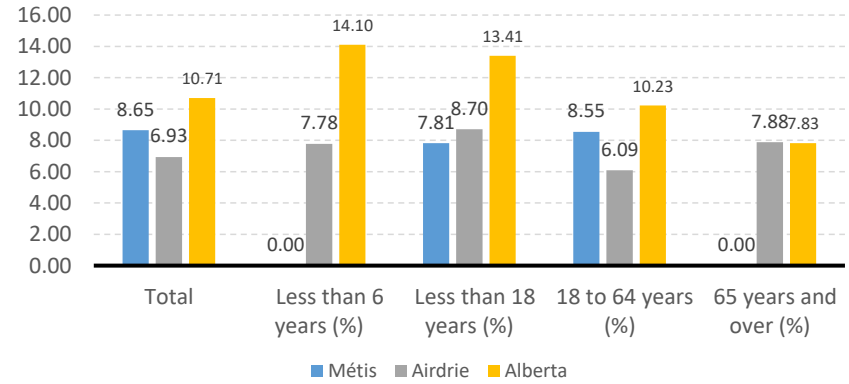
After-Tax Income of Households in 2010



For Métis singles, median after-tax household income is \$80,383, and average after-tax household income is

\$86,344. Métis has lower median and average after-tax income than Airdrie, and higher median and average after-tax income than Alberta.

Prevalence of Low Income in 2010 Based On After-Tax Low-Income Measure (%)



The prevalence of low income based on after-tax low-income measure is 8.65%.

The percentage of low income is 7.81% for people less than 18 years old, 0.00% for people less than 6 years old, 8.55% for people from 18 to 64 years old, and 0.00% for people over 65 years old.
