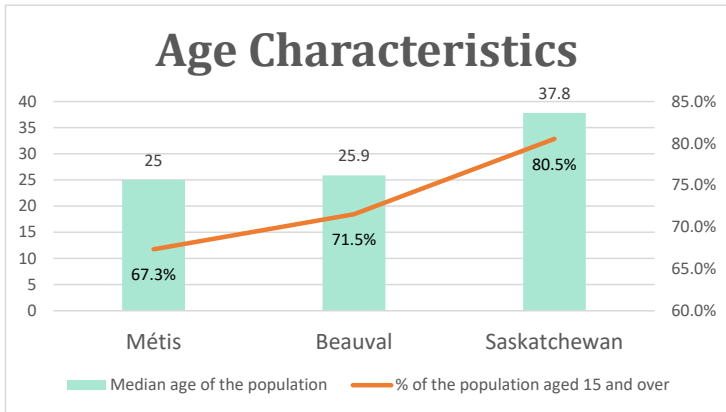

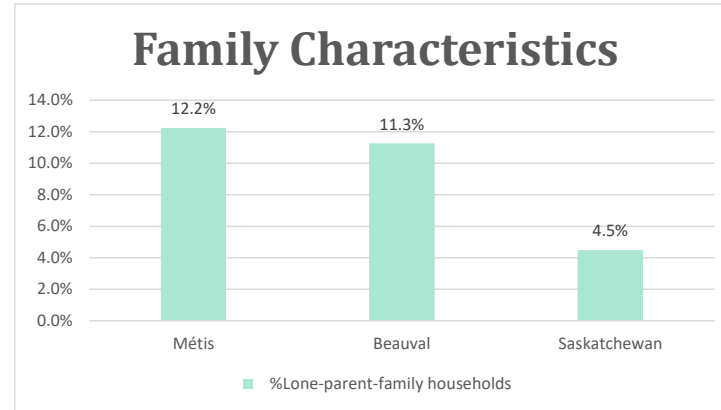

The total population reported with Métis single identity is 490 (Total Métis household is 170), representing 77% of Aboriginal people, accounting for 64.9% of the total population in Beauval.

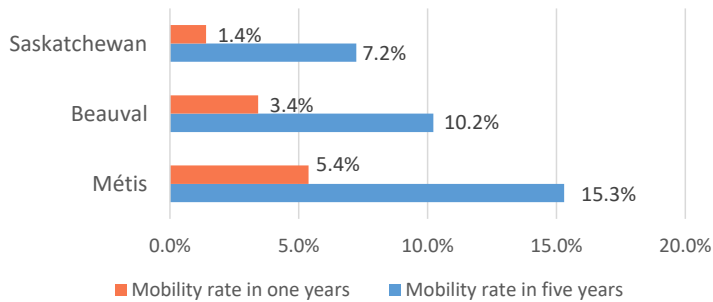


For Métis single identity population, the median age is 25.0 years old, with 67.3% of the population aged 15 and over. As for the total population, the median age is 25.9 in Beauval and 37.8 years old in Saskatchewan, with 71.5% and 80.5% population aged 15 and over respectively.



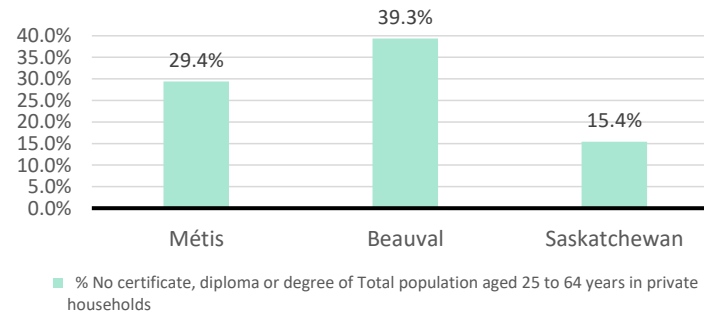
The number of Métis single lone parents household is 60, accounting for 12.2% of the total Métis single private households.

25 Métis households moved in last year (5.4%), 65 Métis households moved in the past 5 years (15.3%).

Education



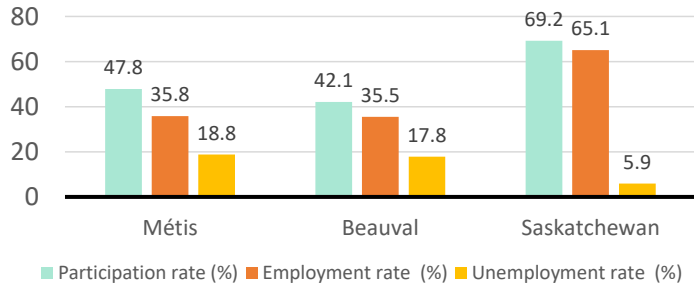
For population aged from 25 to 64 years, 29.4% Métis compared to 39.3% in Beauval and 15.4% in Saskatchewan have no certificate, diploma or degree.

For Métis aged from 25 to 34, 27.3% Métis reported to have no certificate, diploma or degree.

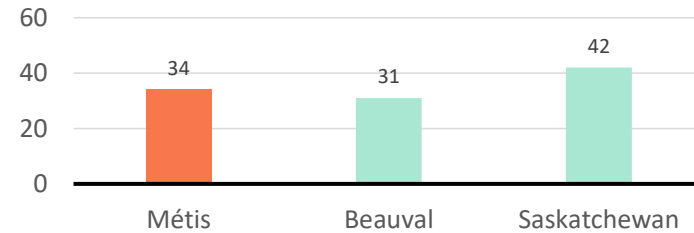
Labour Force Status



Métis participation rate is 47.8%, employment rate is 35.8%, and unemployment rate is 18.8%.

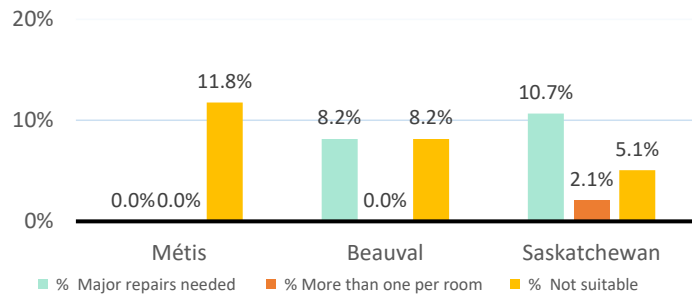
While the participation rate is higher compared with total population in Beauval and lower than Saskatchewan (42.1% and 69.2%), unemployment rate is higher.

Average Weeks Worked in 2010



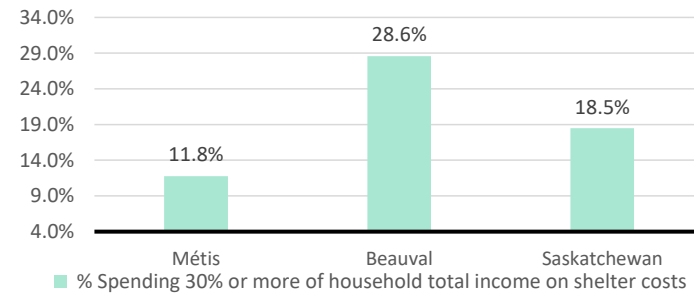
The average weeks worked in 2010 is 34.0 weeks.

Household Characteristics



There are 170 private dwellings occupied by a Métis single household, out of which no Métis single household reported need major repairs or have more than one person per room, 11.8% Métis household reported to be not suitable.

Shelter Costs



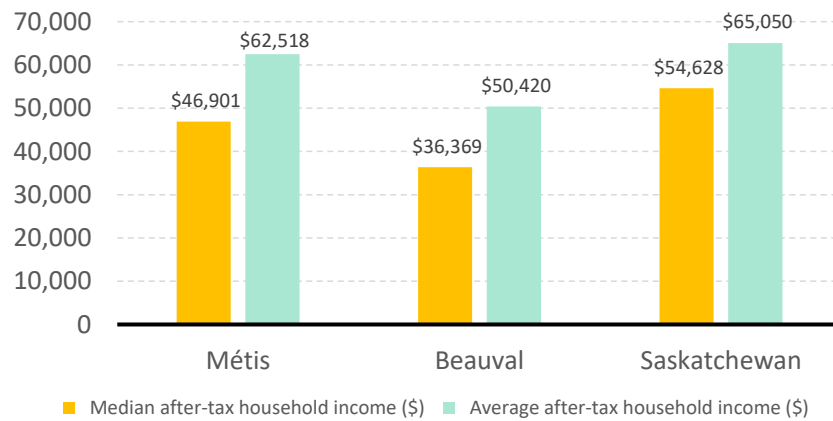
The number of Métis households spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs is 20,

of the total private dwellings occupied by a Métis household, compared to 28.6% of the total population in Beauval and 18.5% of the total population in Saskatchewan.

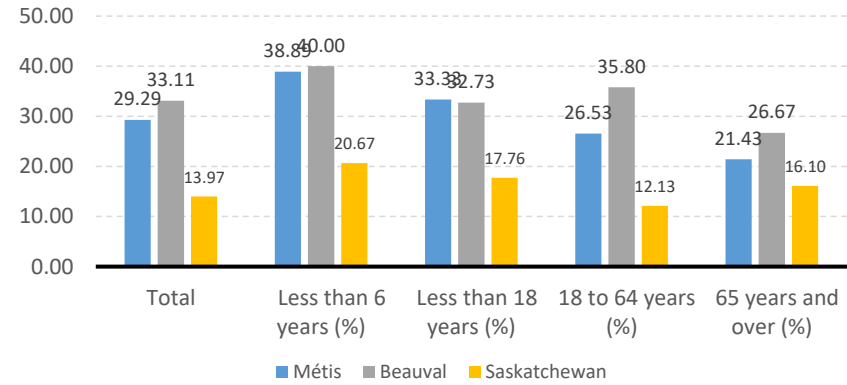
Income

After-Tax Income of Households in 2010



For Métis singles, median after-tax household income is \$46,901, and average after-tax household income is \$62,518. Métis has higher median and average after-tax income than Beauval, and lower median and average after-tax income than Saskatchewan.

Prevalence of Low Income in 2010 Based On After-Tax Low-Income Measure (%)



The prevalence of low income based on after-tax low-income measure is 29.29%.

The percentage of low income is 33.33% for people less than 18 years old, 38.89% for people less than 6 years old, 26.53% for people from 18 to 64 years old, and 21.43% for people over 65 years old.
