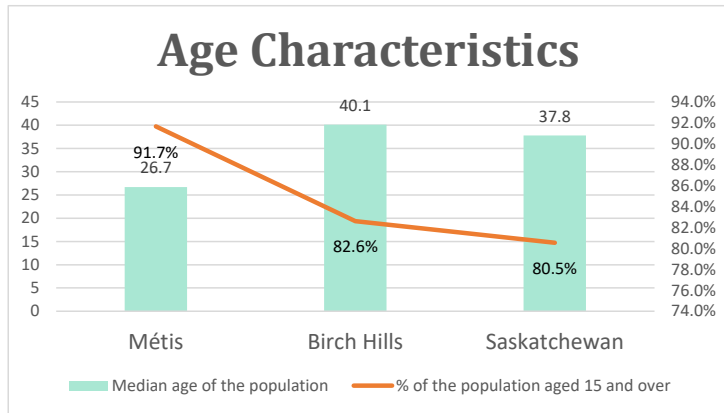

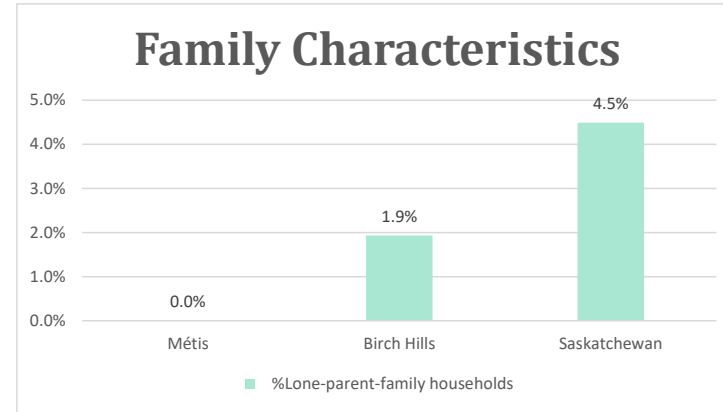

The total population reported with Métis single identity is 120 (Total Métis household is 70), representing 83% of Aboriginal people, accounting for 11.6% of the total population in Birch Hills.

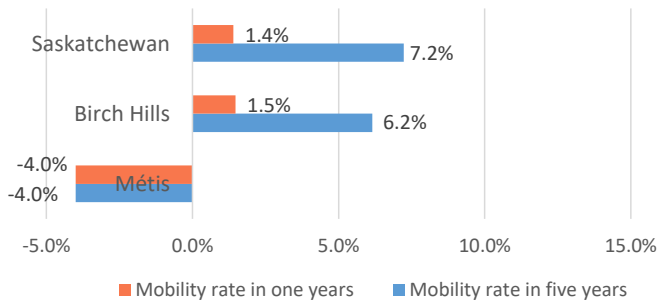


For Métis single identity population, the median age is 26.7 years old, with 91.7% of the population aged 15 and over. As for the total population, the median age is 40.1 in Birch Hills and 37.8 years old in Saskatchewan, with 82.6% and 80.5% population aged 15 and over respectively.



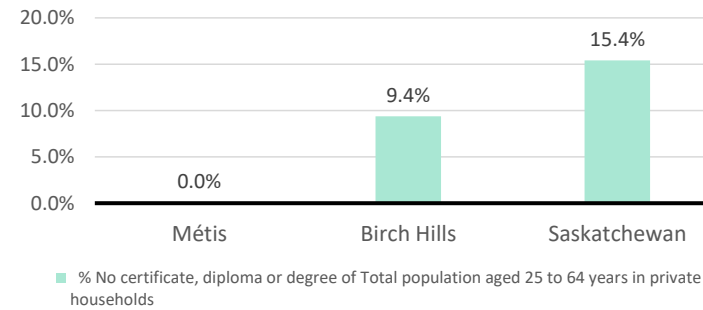

Education



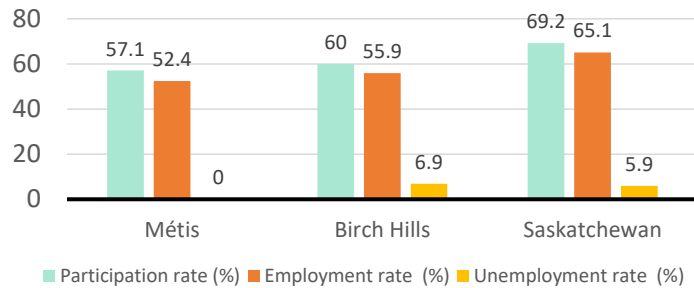
For population aged from 25 to 64 years, no Métis reported have no certificate, diploma or degree.

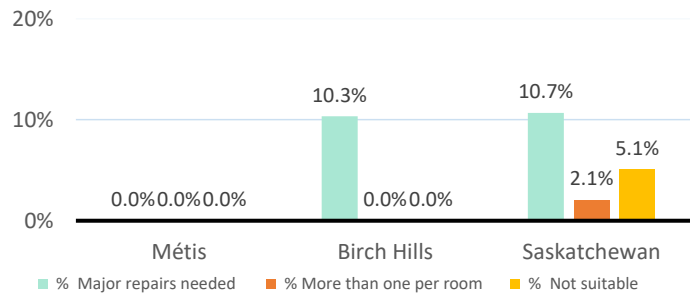
Labour Force Status



Métis participation rate is 57.1%, employment rate is 52.4%, and unemployment rate is 0.0%.

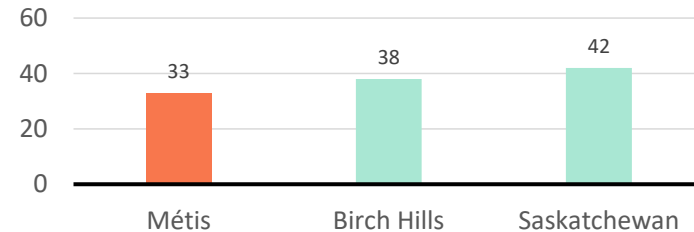
While the participation rate is lower compared with total population in Birch Hills and Saskatchewan (60.0% and 69.2%), no Métis reported unemployment.

Household Characteristics



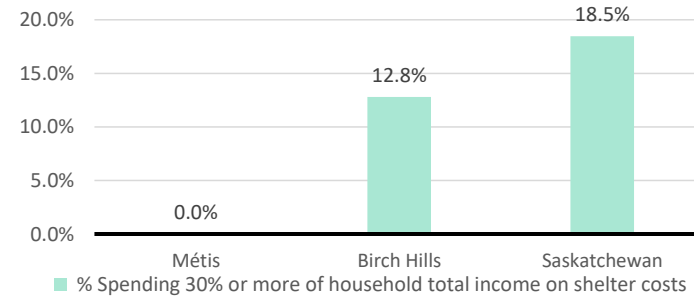
There are 70 private dwellings occupied by a Métis single household, out of which no Métis single household reported need major repairs, have more than one person per room, or not suitable.

Shelter Costs



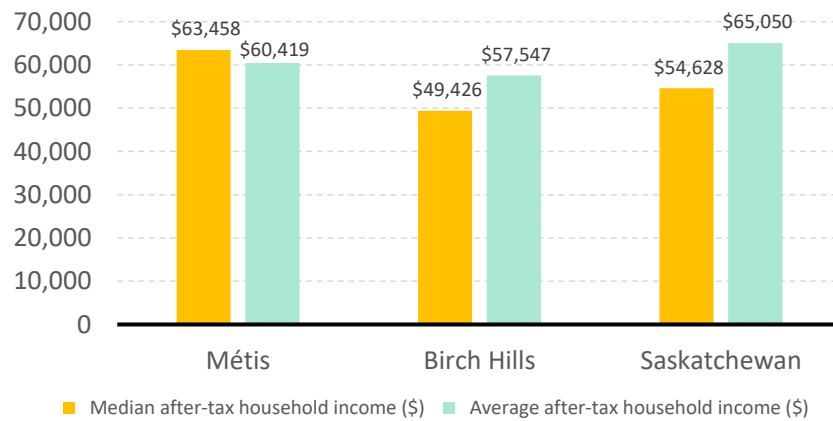
No Métis households reported spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs,

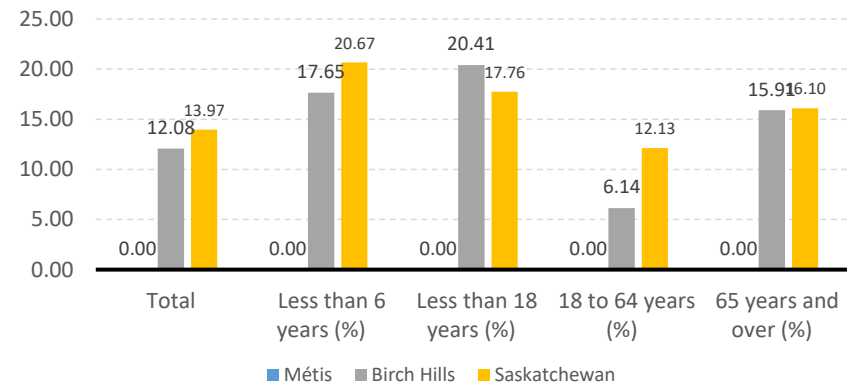
After-Tax Income of Households in 2010
