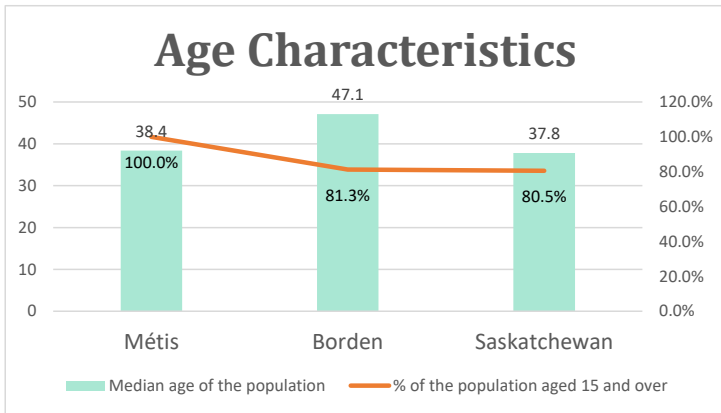

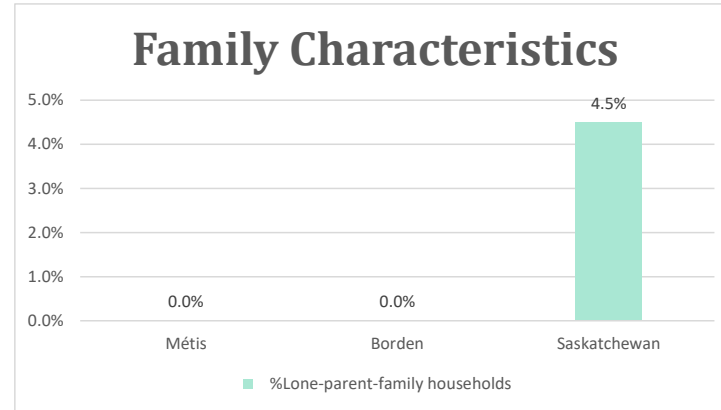

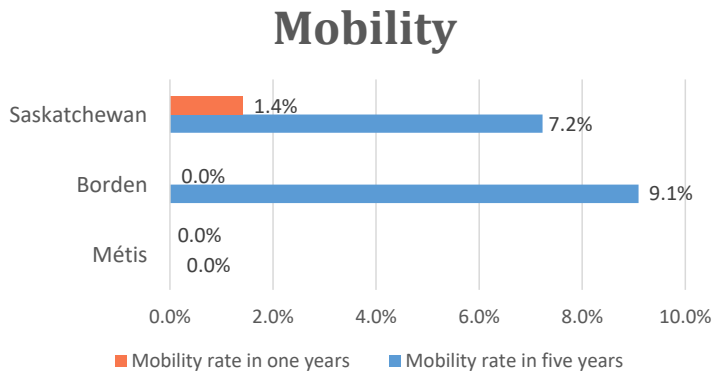
The total population reported with Métis single identity is 25 (Total Métis household is 00), representing 100% of Aboriginal people, accounting for 10.4% of the total population in Borden.



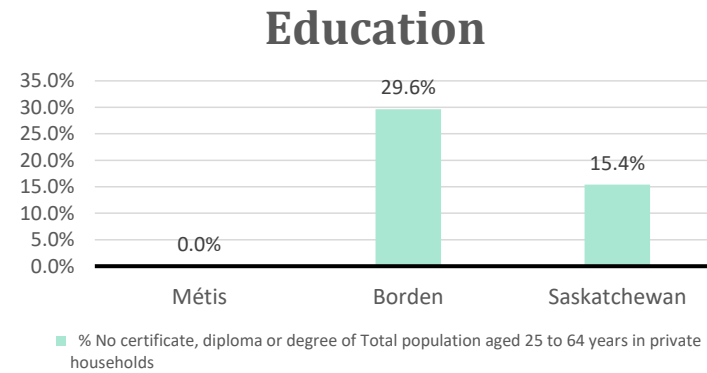

No Métis households reported moving in for the last 5 years.



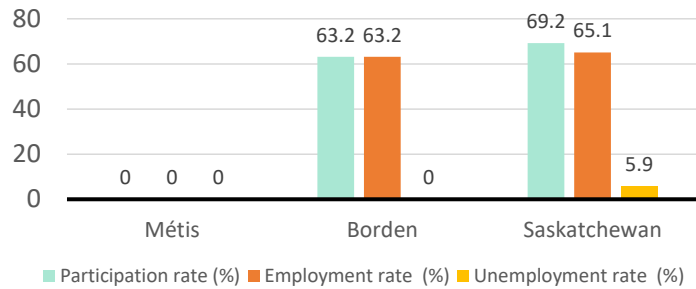

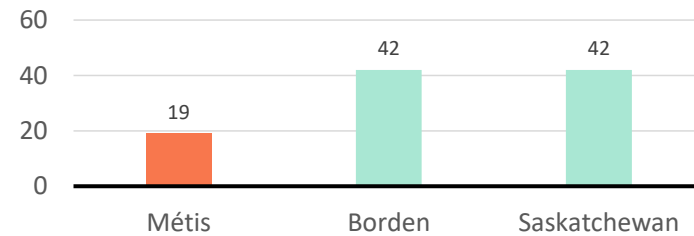

Labour Force Status



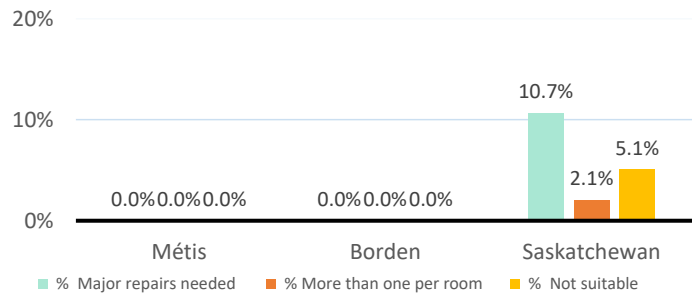

Average Weeks Worked in 2010



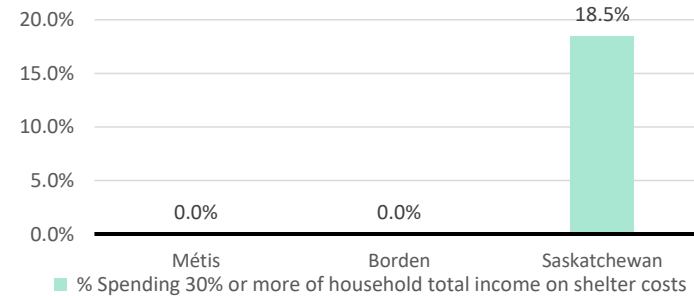
The average weeks worked in 2010 is 19.0 weeks.

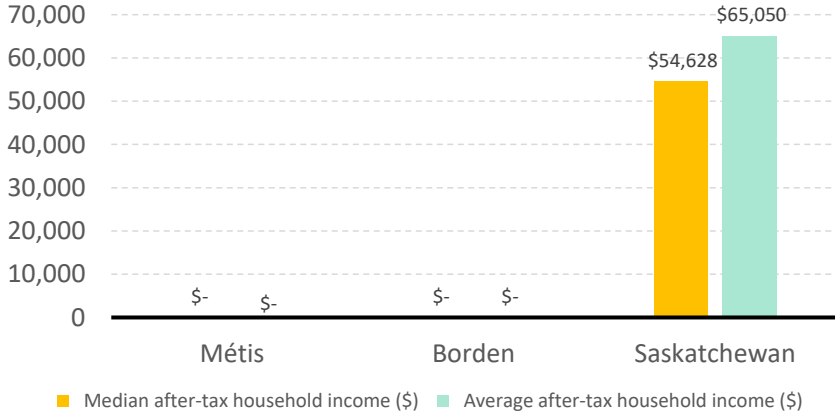

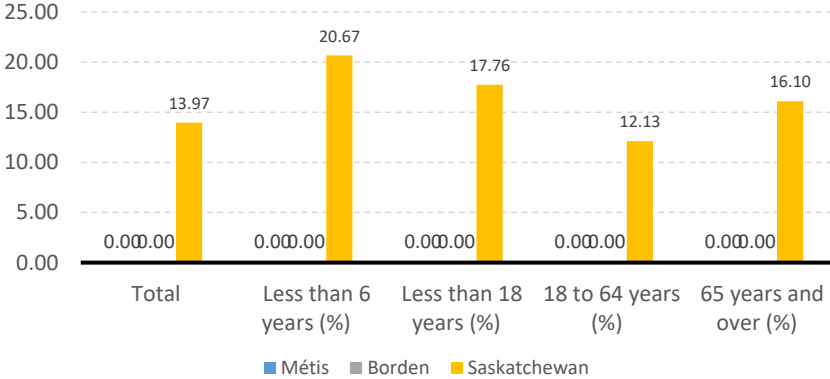
