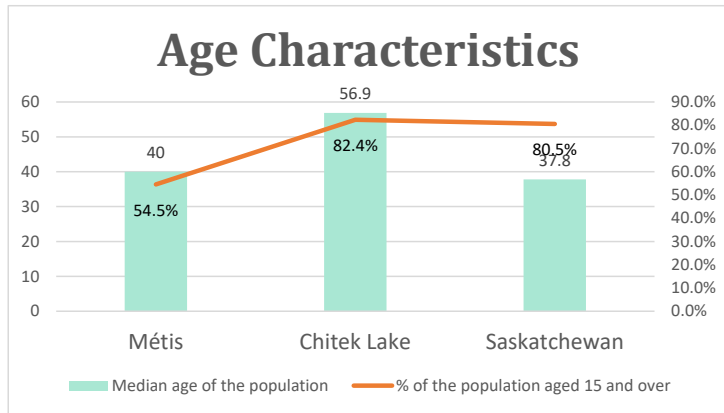


# Chitek Lake, SK

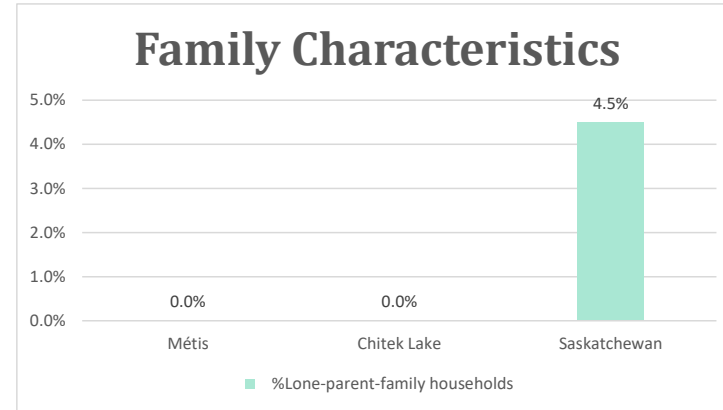

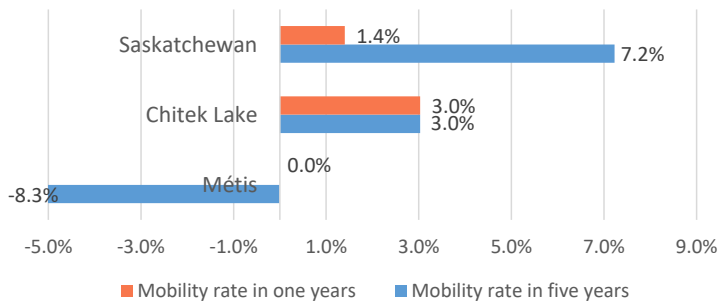

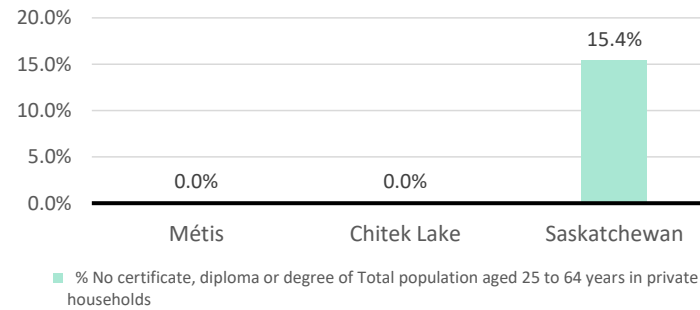
No Métis single lone parents household reported to the survey.

## Education



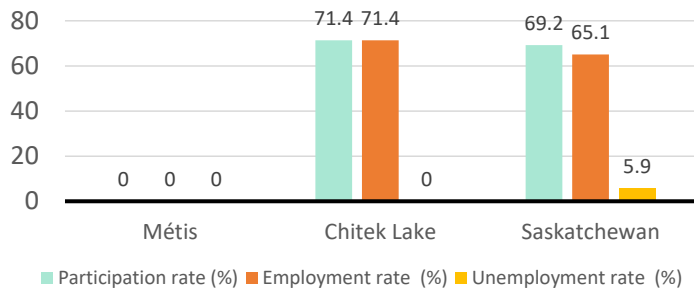
For population aged from 25 to 64 years, no Métis reported have no certificate, diploma or degree.

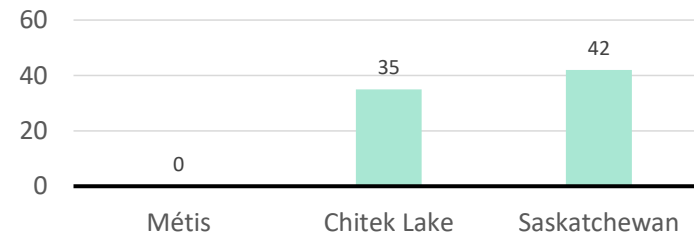

### Labour Force Status



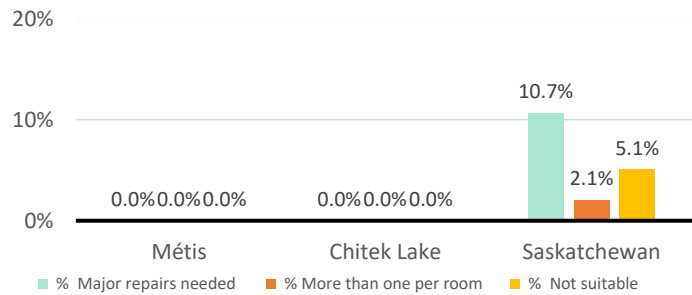

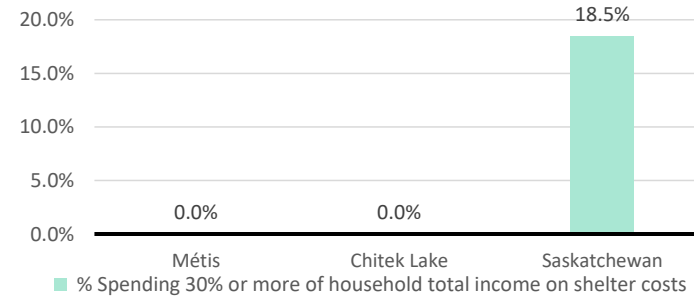

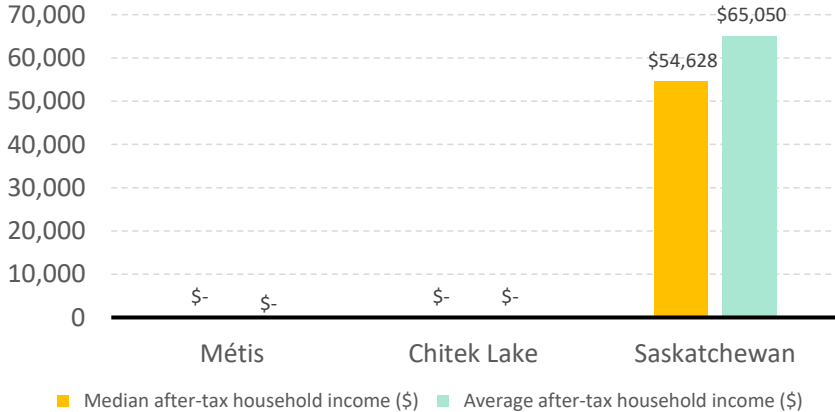

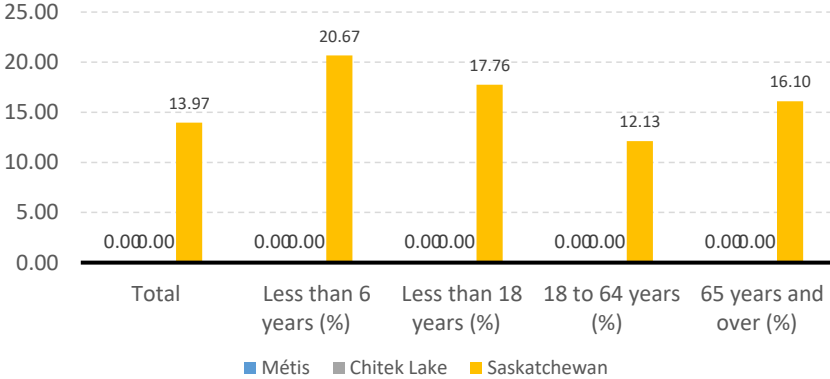
