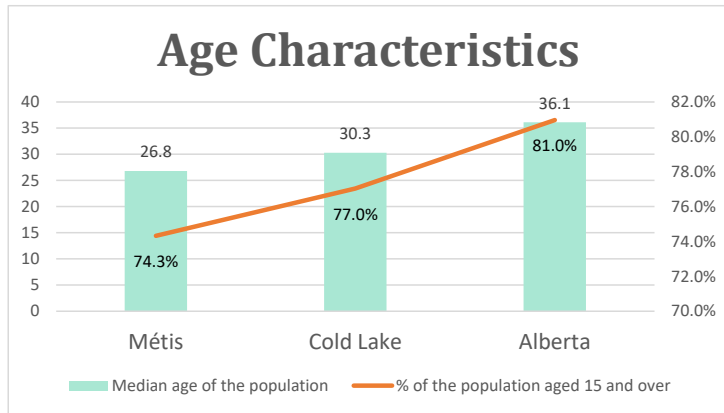


# Cold Lake, AB

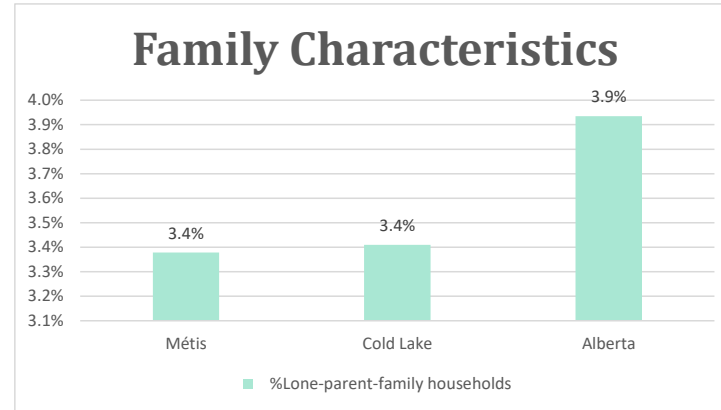

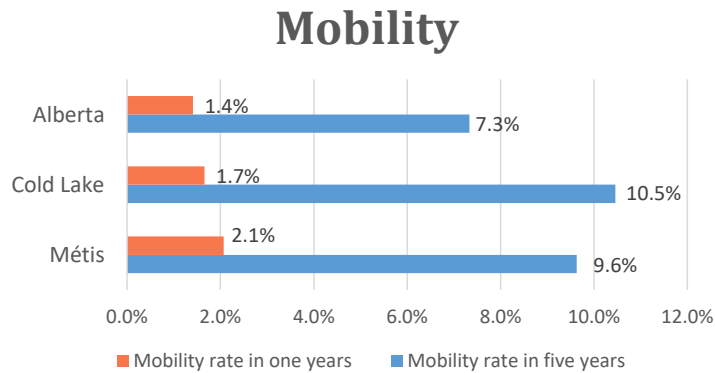
The total population reported with Métis single identity is 740 (Total Métis household is 415), representing 56% of Aboriginal people, accounting for 5.4% of the total population in Cold Lake.



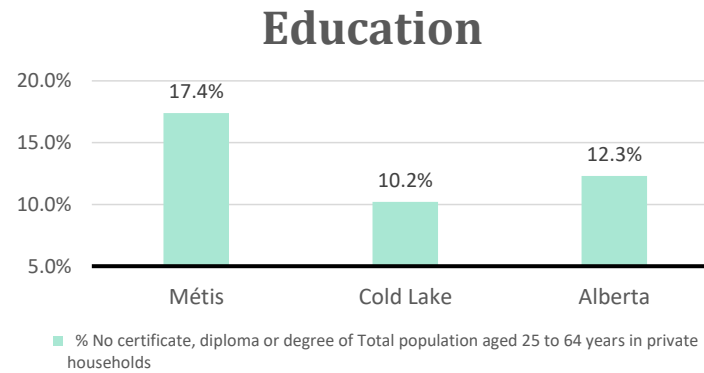
For Métis single identity population, the median age is 26.8 years old, with 74.3% of the population aged 15 and over. As for the total population, the median age is 30.3 in Cold Lake and 36.1 years old in Alberta, with 77.0% and 81.0% population aged 15 and over respectively.



The number of Métis single lone parents household is 25, accounting for 3.4% of the total Métis single private households.



15 Métis households moved in last year (2.1%), 65 Métis households moved in the past 5 years (9.6%).



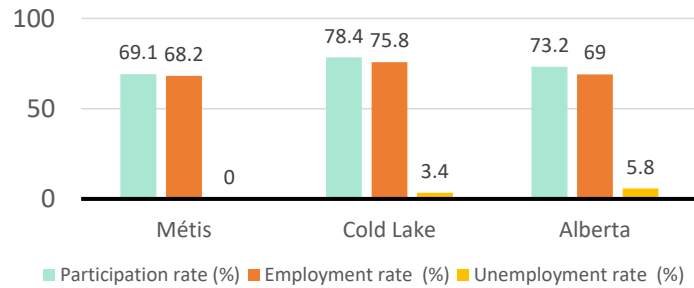
For population aged from 25 to 64 years, 17.4% Métis compared to 10.2% in Cold Lake and 12.3% in Alberta have no certificate, diploma or degree.

For Métis aged from 25 to 34, no Métis reported have no certificate, diploma or degree.

## Labor Force & Housing Statistics

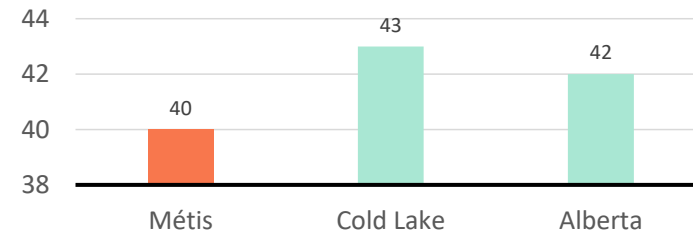
### Labour Force Status



Métis participation rate is 69.1%, employment rate is 68.2%, and unemployment rate is 0.0%.

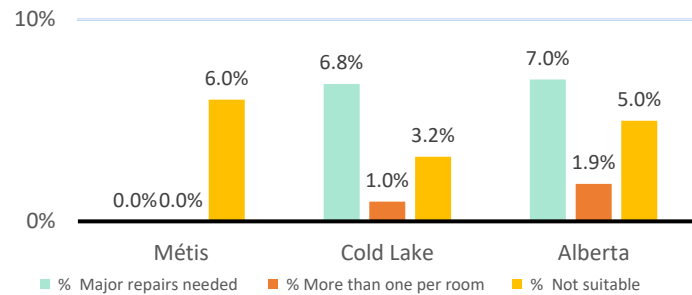
While the participation rate is lower compared with total population in Cold Lake and Alberta (78.4% and 73.2%), no Métis reported unemployment.

### Average Weeks Worked in 2010



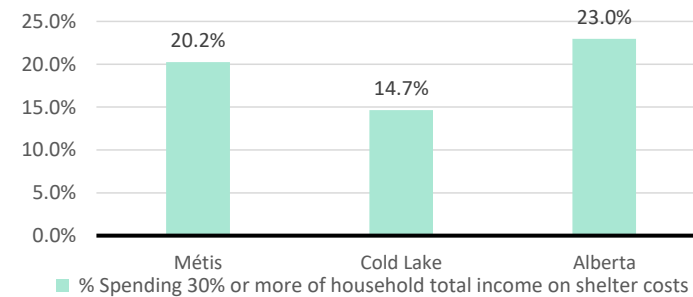
The average weeks worked in 2010 is 40.0 weeks.

### Household Characteristics



There are 415 private dwellings occupied by a Métis single household, out of which no Métis single household reported need major repairs or have more than one person per room, 6.0% Métis household reported to be not suitable.

### Shelter Costs



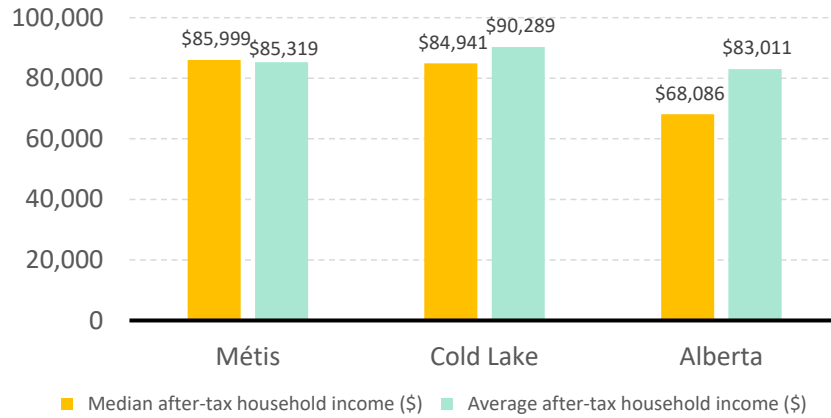
The number of Métis households spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs is 85, which is 20.2%

of the total private dwellings occupied by a Métis household, compared to 14.7% of the total population in Cold Lake and 23.0% of the total population in Alberta.

## Income

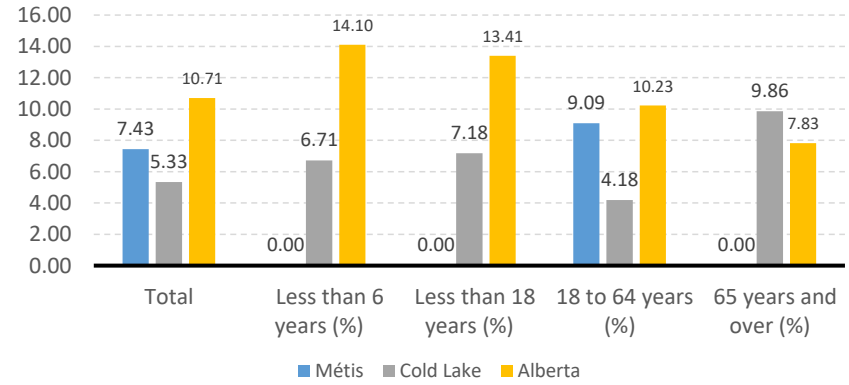
After-Tax Income of Households in 2010



For Métis singles, median after-tax household income is \$85,999, and average after-tax household income is

\$85,319. Métis has higher median and lower average after-tax income than Cold Lake, and higher median and average after-tax income than Alberta.

Prevalence of Low Income in 2010 Based On After-Tax Low-Income Measure (%)



The prevalence of low income based on after-tax low-income measure is 7.43%.

The percentage of low income is 9.09% for people from 18 to 64 years old, and no Métis household reported low income in other age groups.
