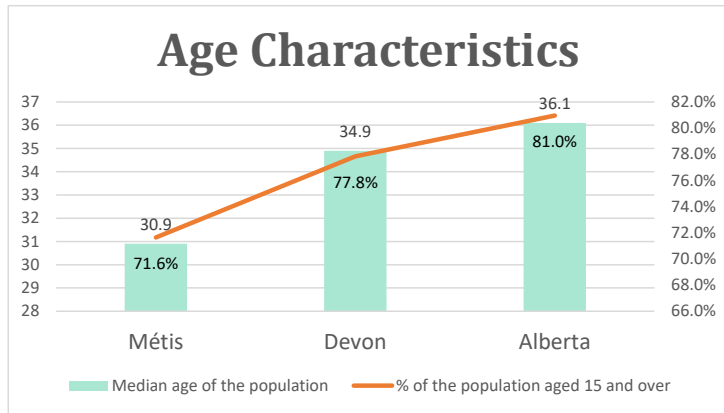

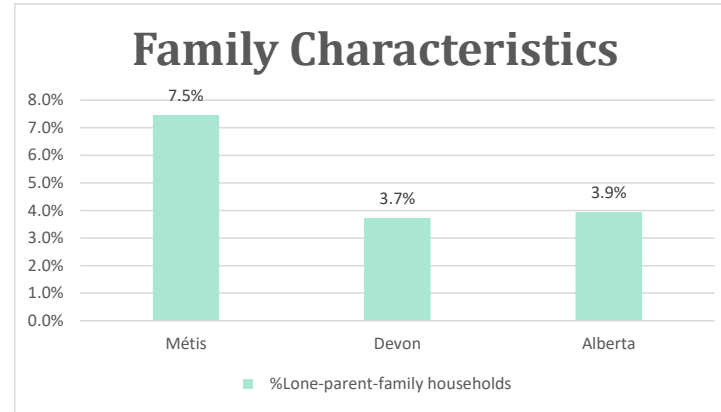

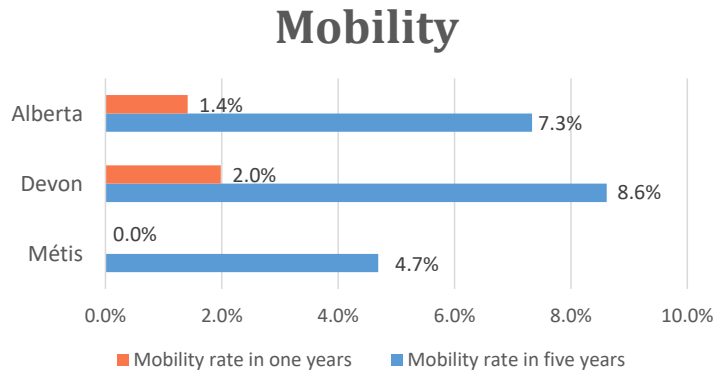
The total population reported with Métis single identity is 335 (Total Métis household is 180), representing 74% of Aboriginal people, accounting for 5.2% of the total population in Devon.



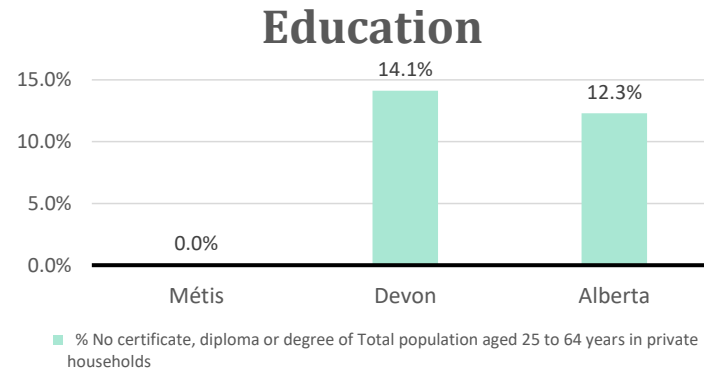
For Métis single identity population, the median age is 30.9 years old, with 71.6% of the population aged 15 and over. As for the total population, the median age is 34.9 in Devon and 36.1 years old in Alberta, with 77.8% and 81.0% population aged 15 and over respectively.



The number of Métis single lone parents household is 25, accounting for 7.5% of the total Métis single private households.



No Métis households reported moving in for the last year. 15 Métis households moved in the past 5 years (4.7%).



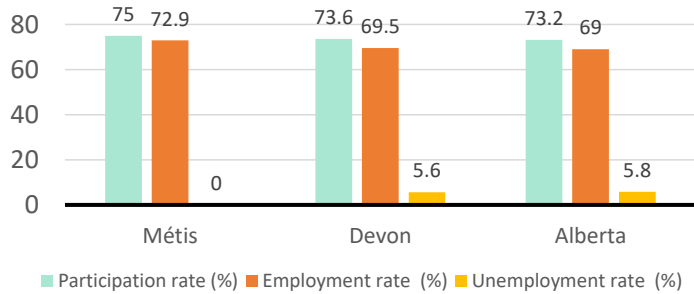
For population aged from 25 to 64 years, no Métis reported have no certificate, diploma or degree.

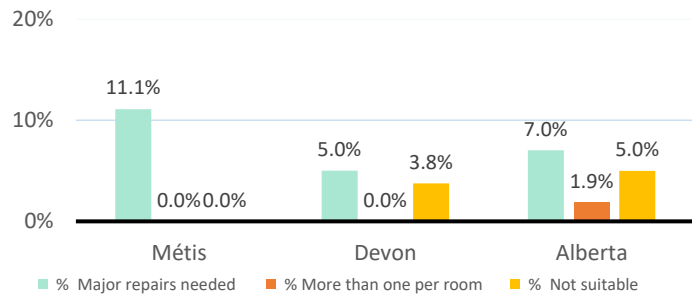
Labour Force Status



Métis participation rate is 75.0%, employment rate is 72.9%, and unemployment rate is 0.0%.

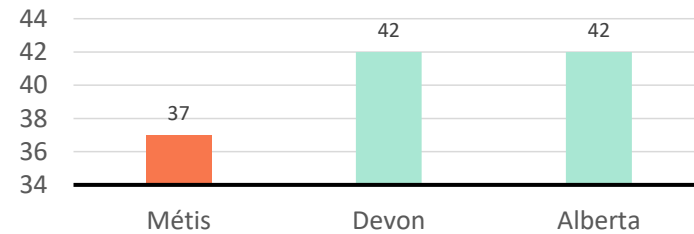
While the participation rate is higher compared with total population in Devon and Alberta (73.6% and 73.2%), no Métis reported unemployment.

Household Characteristics



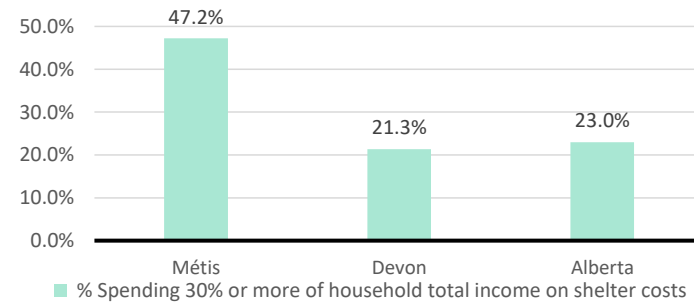
There are 180 private dwellings occupied by a Métis single household, out of which 11.1% need major repairs, no Métis household reported have more than one person per room, and no Métis household reported to be not suitable.

Shelter Costs



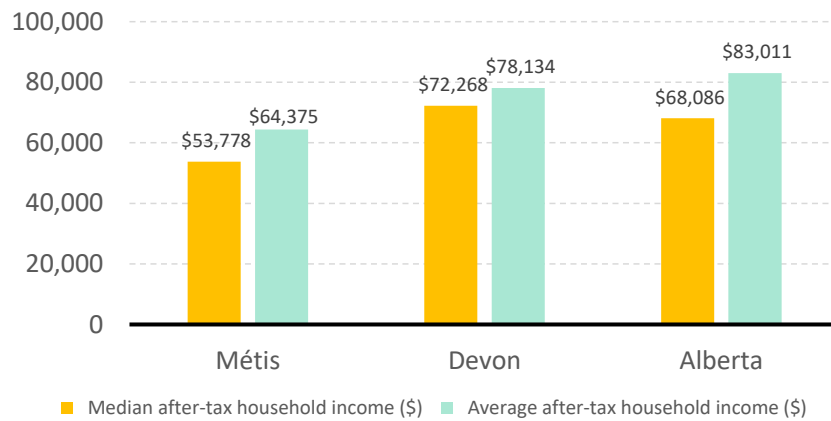
The number of Métis households spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs is 85, which is 47.2%

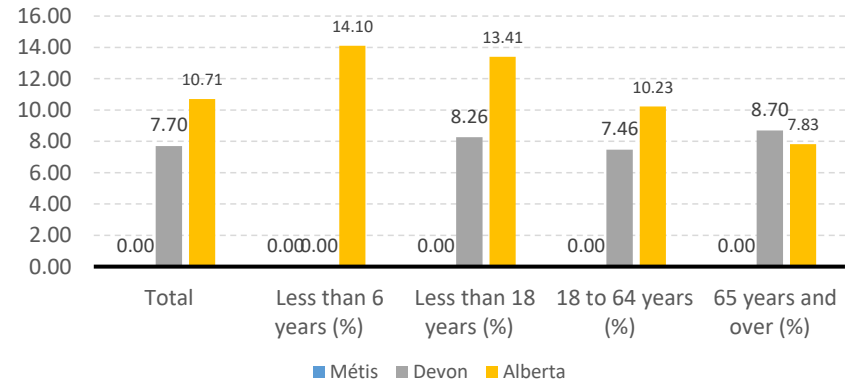
After-Tax Income of Households in 2010



For Métis singles, median after-tax household income is \$53,778, and average after-tax household income is
