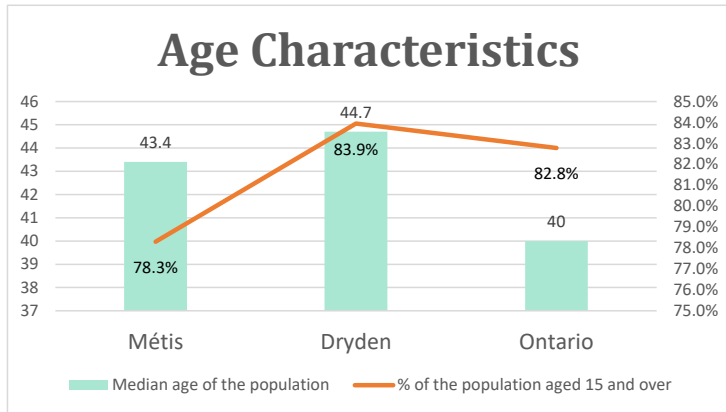

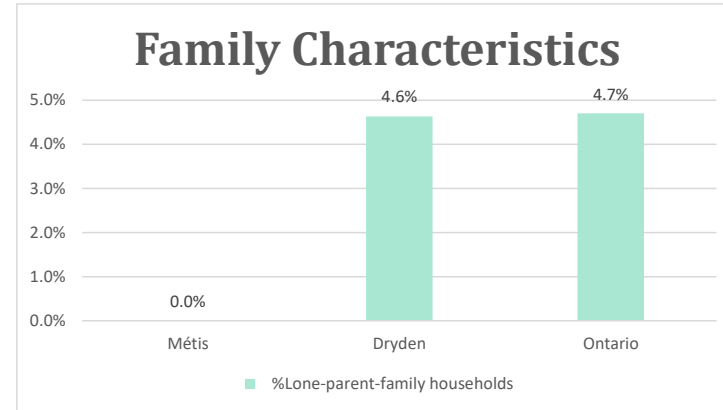

The total population reported with Métis single identity is 530 (Total Métis household is 335), representing 45% of Aboriginal people, accounting for 7.1% of the total population in Dryden.

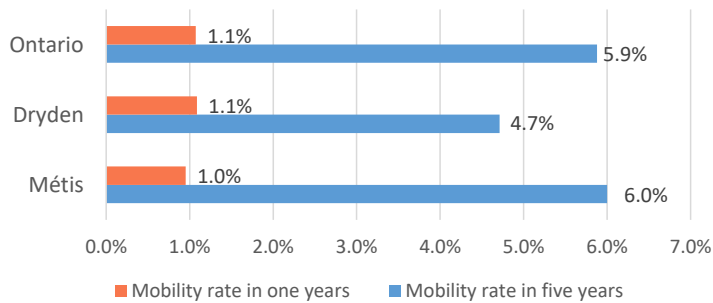


For Métis single identity population, the median age is 43.4 years old, with 78.3% of the population aged 15 and over. As for the total population, the median age is 44.7 in Dryden and 40.0 years old in Ontario, with 83.9% and 82.8% of the population aged 15 and over respectively.



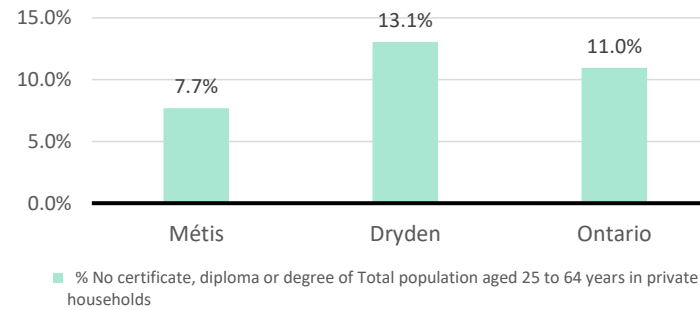
No Métis single lone parents household reported to the survey.

Education



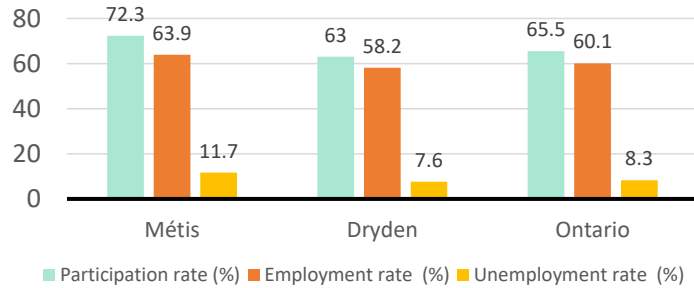
For population aged from 25 to 64 years, 7.7% Métis compared to 13.1% in Dryden and 11.0% in Ontario have no certificate, diploma or degree.

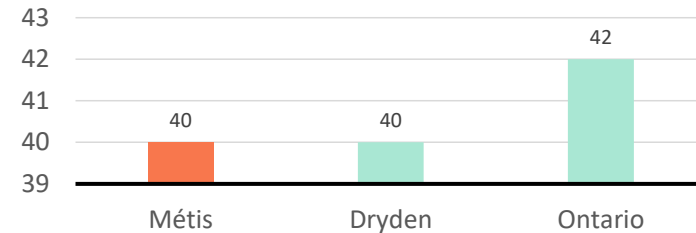
Labour Force Status



Métis participation rate is 72.3%, employment rate is 63.9%, and unemployment rate is 11.7%.

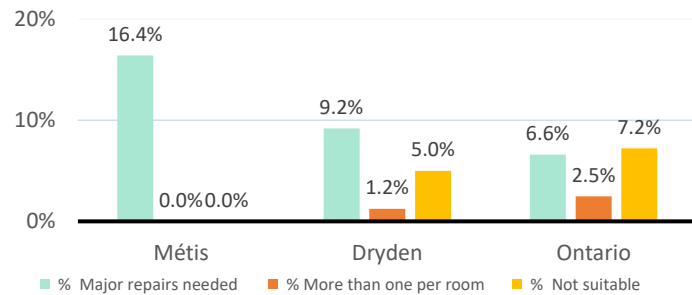
While the participation rate is higher compared with total population in Dryden and Ontario (63.0% and 65.5%), unemployment rate is also higher.

Average Weeks Worked in 2010



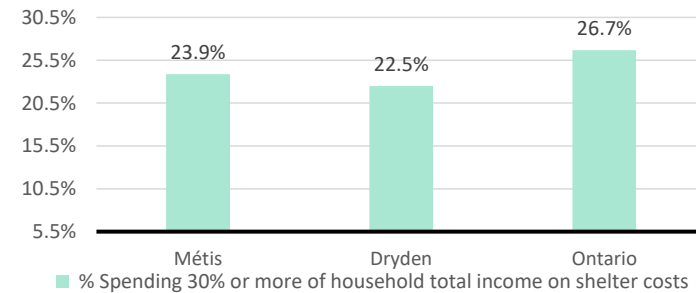
The average weeks worked in 2010 is 40.0 weeks.

Household Characteristics



There are 335 private dwellings occupied by a Métis single household, out of which 16.4% need major repairs, no Métis household reported have more than one person per room, and no Métis household reported to be not suitable.

Shelter Costs



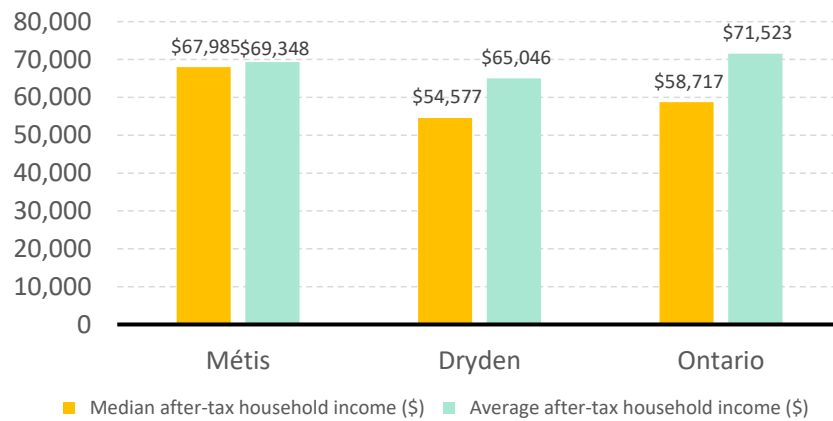
The number of Métis households spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs is 80, which is 23.9%

of the total private dwellings occupied by an Métis household, compared to 22.5% of the total population in Dryden and 26.7% of the total population in Ontario.

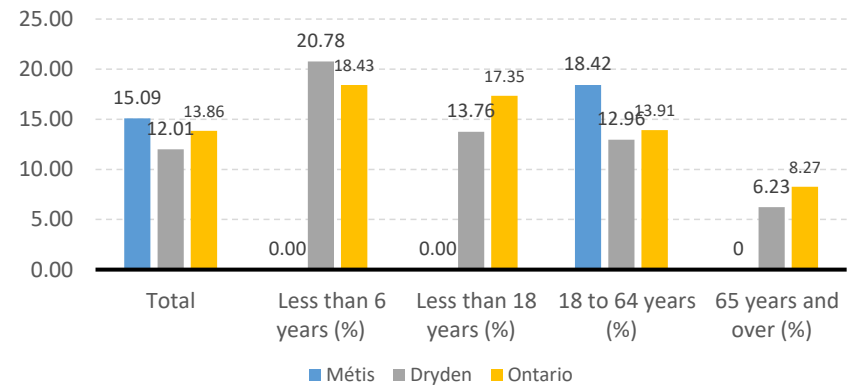
Income

After-Tax Income of Households in 2010



For Métis singles, median after-tax household income is \$67,985, and average after-tax household income is \$69,348. Métis has higher median and average after-tax income than Dryden, and higher median and lower average after-tax income than Ontario.

Prevalence of Low Income in 2010 Based On After-Tax Low-Income Measure (%)



The prevalence of low income based on after-tax low-income measure is 15.09%.

The percentage of low income is 18.42% for people from 18 to 64 years old, and no Métis household reported low income in other age groups.
