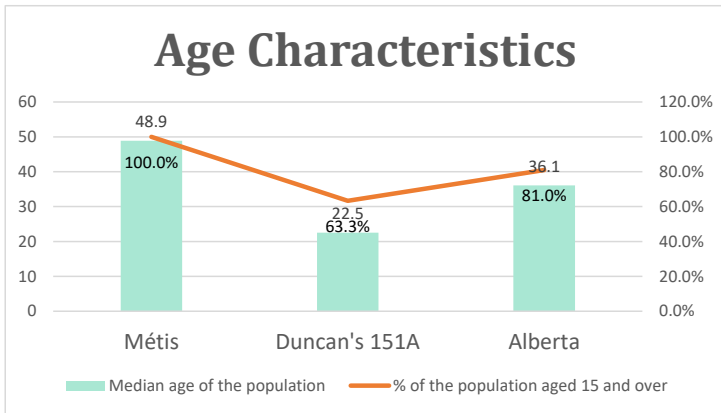


# Duncan's 151A, AB

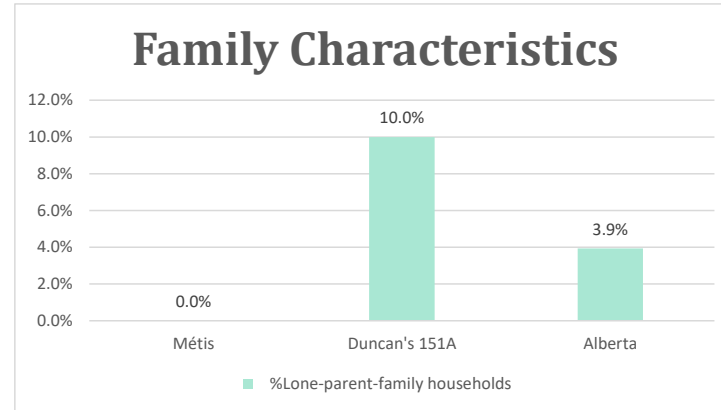

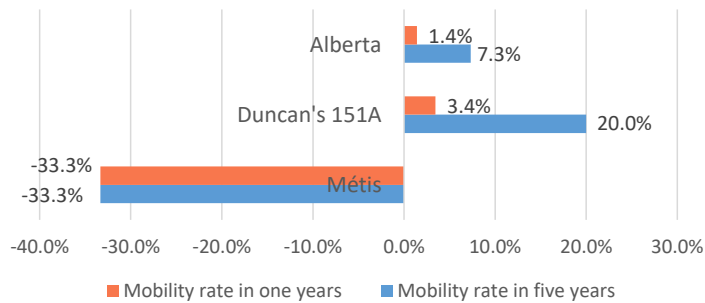

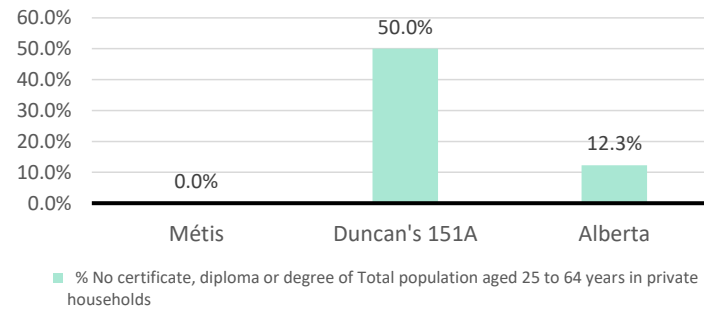

## Education



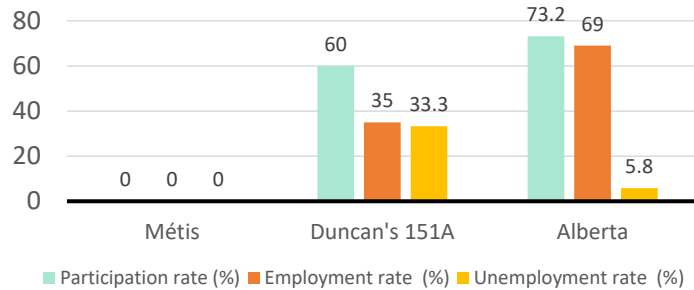

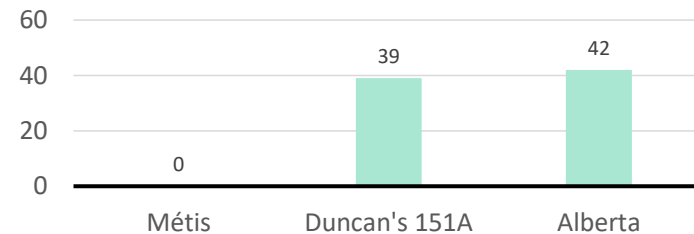

### Labour Force Status



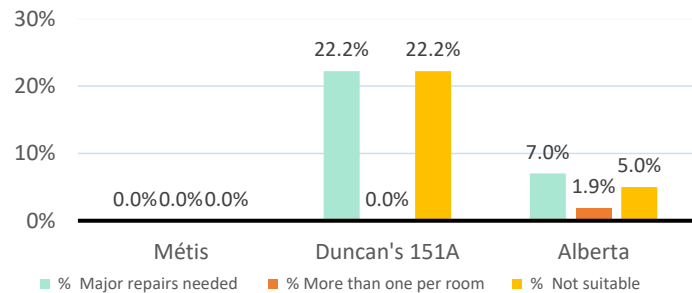

### Average Weeks Worked in 2010



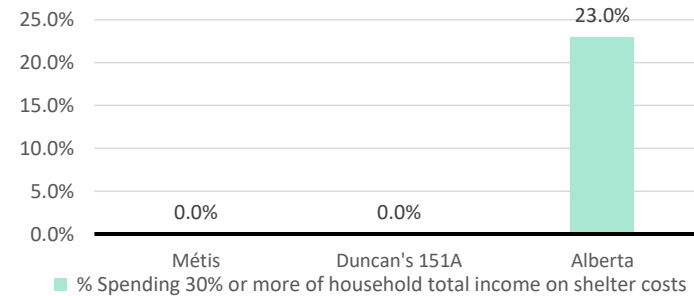

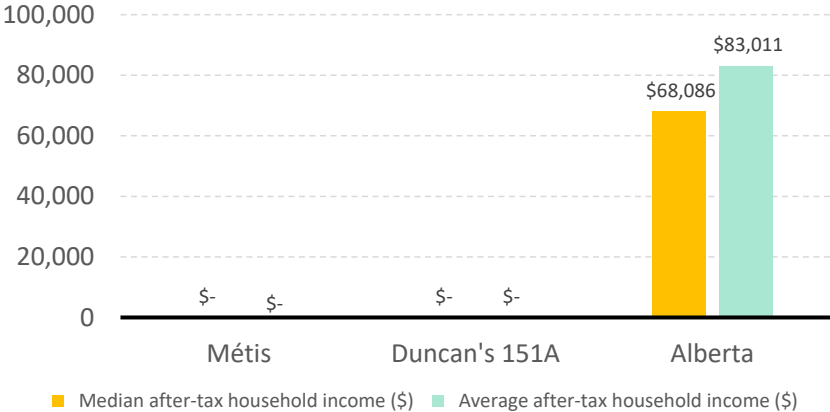

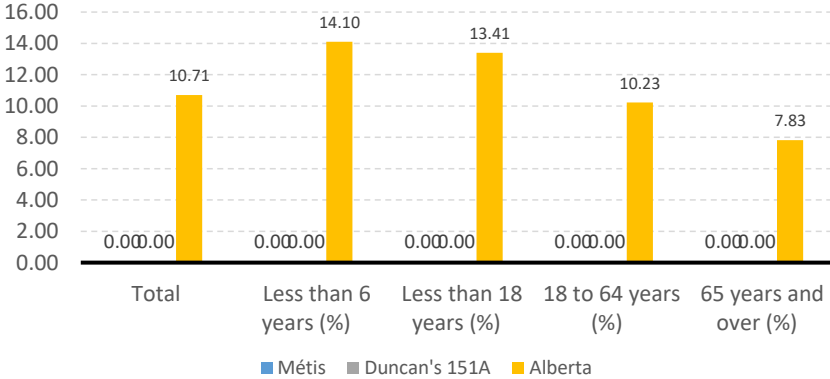
## Income
