




The total population reported with Métis single identity is 270 (Total Métis household is 120), representing 64% of Aboriginal people, accounting for 19.9% of the total population in Grahamdale.



For Métis single identity population, the median age is 19.6 years old, with 79.6% of the population aged 15 and over. As for the total population, the median age is 49.1 in Grahamdale and 37.9 years old in Manitoba, with 85.2% and 80.6% population aged 15 and over respectively.






Labor Force & Housing Statistics



Métis participation rate is 52.4%, employment rate is 47.6%, and unemployment rate is 0.0%.


While the participation rate is lower compared with total population in Grahamdale and Manitoba (60.2% and 67.3), no Métis reported unemployment.

Household Characteristics






After-Tax Income of Households in 2010

For Métis singles, median after-tax household income is \$26,383, and average after-tax household income is \$51,762. Métis has lower median after-tax household income than Grahamdale and Manitoba. Métis has higher average after-tax household income than Grahamdale but lower than Manitoba.

The prevalence of low income based on after-tax low-income measure is 57.41%.
