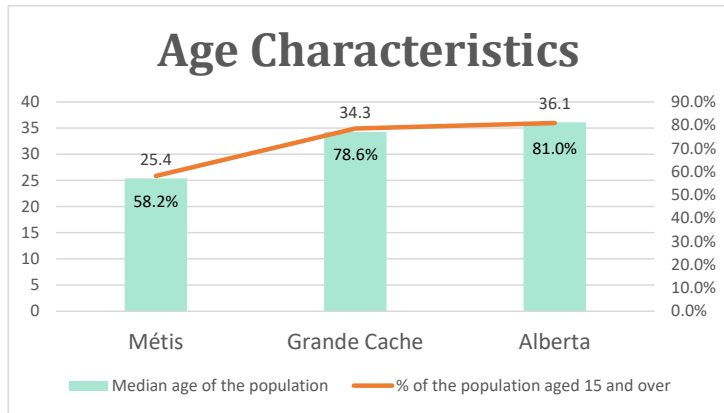

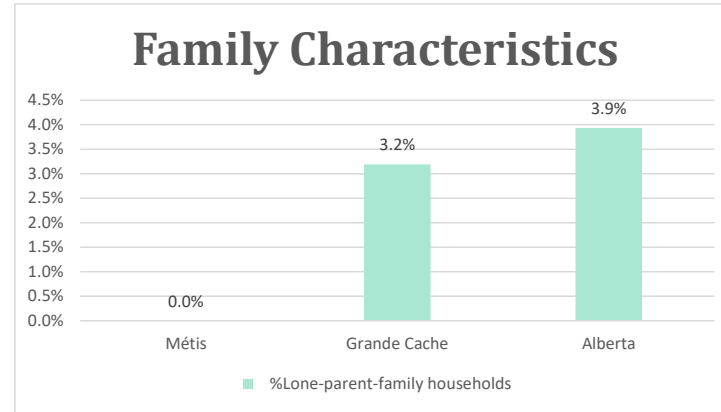

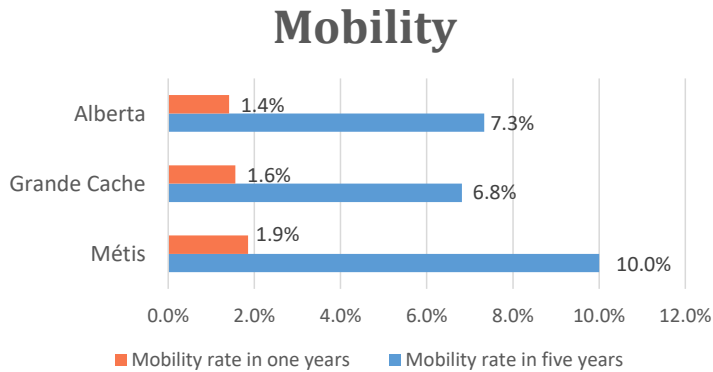
The total population reported with Métis single identity is 275 (Total Métis household is 150), representing 55% of Aboriginal people, accounting for 6.5% of the total population in Grande Cache.



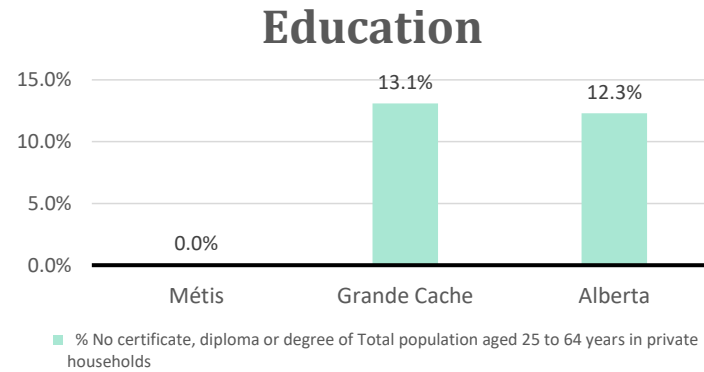
For Métis single identity population, the median age is 25.4 years old, with 58.2% of the population aged 15 and over. As for the total population, the median age is 34.3 in Grande Cache and 36.1 years old in Alberta, with 78.6% and 81.0% population aged 15 and over respectively.

5 Métis households moved in last year (1.9%), 25 Métis households moved in the past 5 years (10.0%).



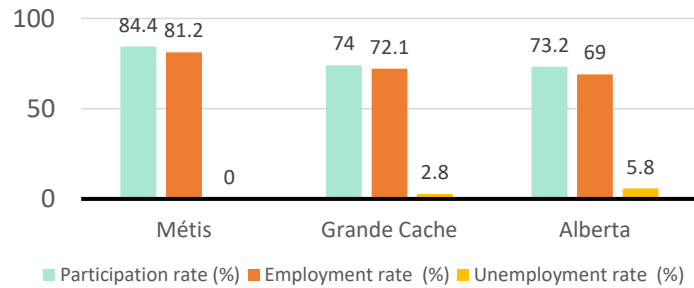
For population aged from 25 to 64 years, no Métis reported have no certificate, diploma or degree.

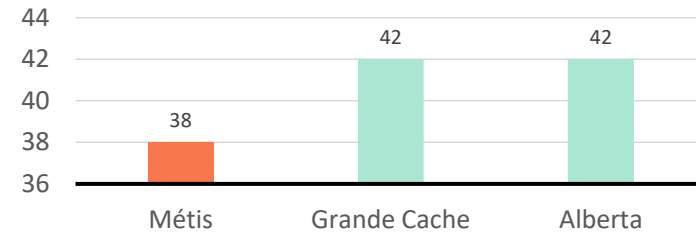
Labour Force Status



Métis participation rate is 84.4%, employment rate is 81.2%, and unemployment rate is 0.0%.

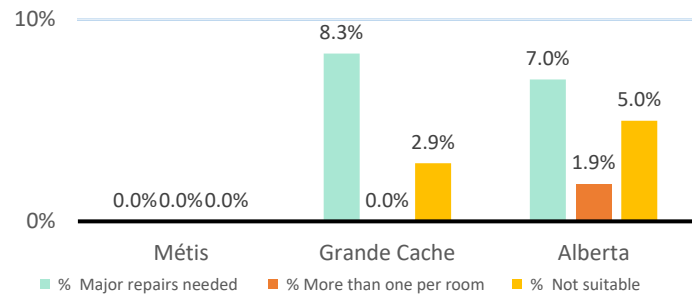
While the participation rate is higher compared with total population in Grande Cache and Alberta (74.0% and 73.2%), no Métis reported unemployment.

Average Weeks Worked in 2010



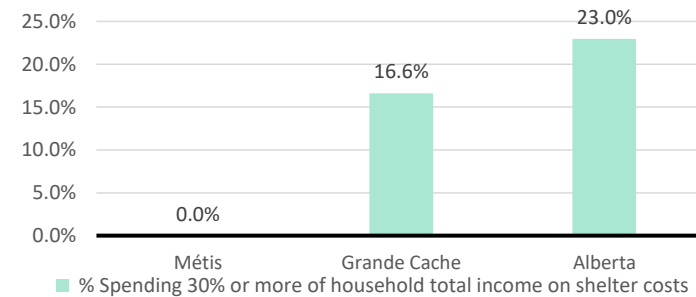
The average weeks worked in 2010 is 38.0 weeks.

Shelter Costs



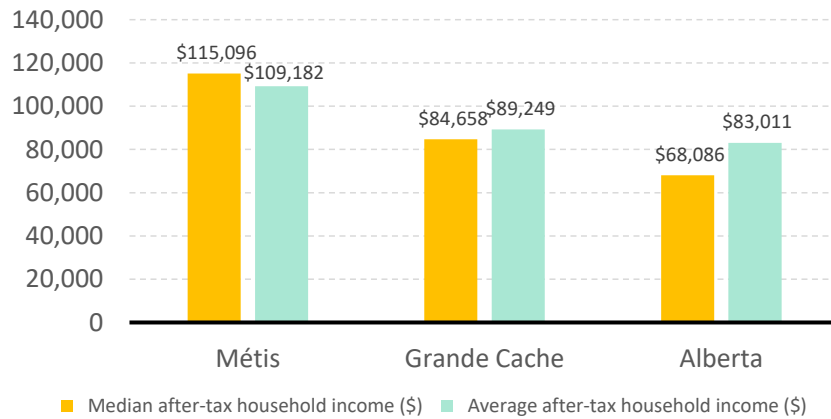
No Métis households reported spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs,

Income

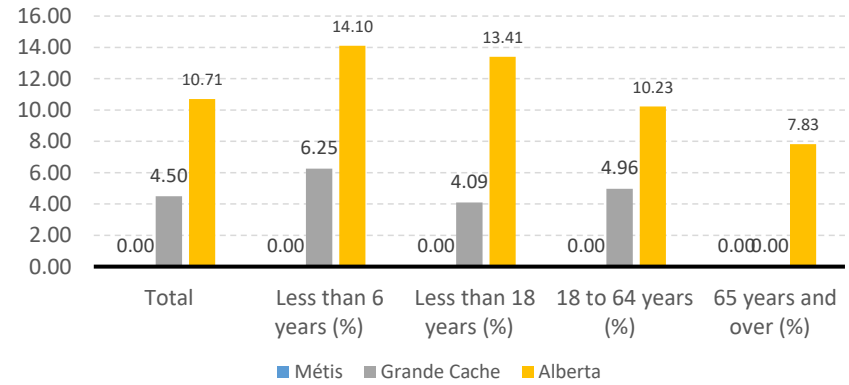
After-Tax Income of Households in 2010



For Métis singles, median after-tax household income is \$115,096, and average after-tax household income is

\$109,182. Métis has higher median and average after-tax income than Grande Cache and Alberta.
