






## **Labor Force & Housing Statistics**



Métis participation rate is 75.0%, employment rate is 67.9%, and unemployment rate is 0.0%.


While the participation rate is higher compared with total population in Greenview No. 16 and Alberta (71.0% and 73.2%), no Métis reported unemployment.

#### **Household Characteristics**




There are 235 private dwellings occupied by a Métis single household, out of which no Métis single household reported need major repairs, have more than one person per room, or not suitable.

#### **Shelter Costs**




No Métis households reported spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs,

#### After-Tax Income of Households in 2010




■ Median after-tax household income (\$) ■ Average after-tax household income (\$)

For Métis singles, median after-tax household income is \$70,755, and average after-tax household income is

\$77,646. Métis has higher median and lower average after-tax income than Greenview No. 16, and higher median and lower average after-tax income than Alberta.

The prevalence of low income based on after-tax low-income measure is 21.62%.

The percentage of low income is 31.11% for people from 18 to 64 years old, and no Métis household reporeted low income in other age groups.
