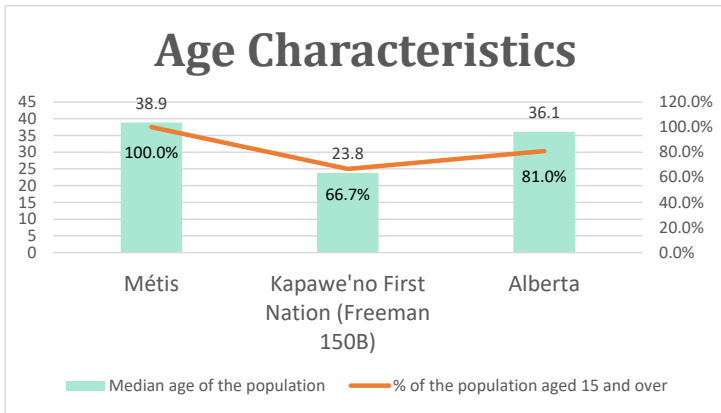

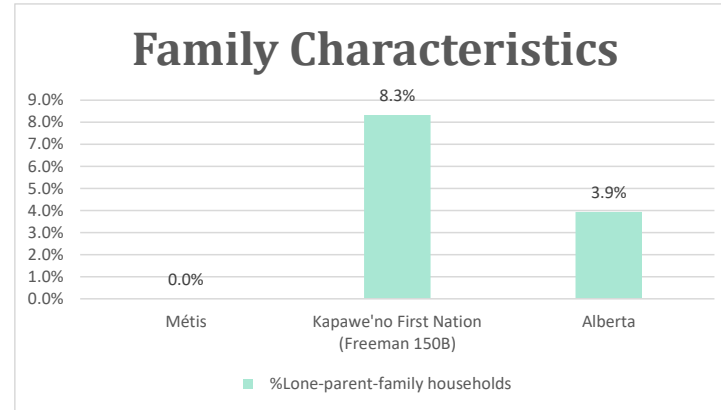

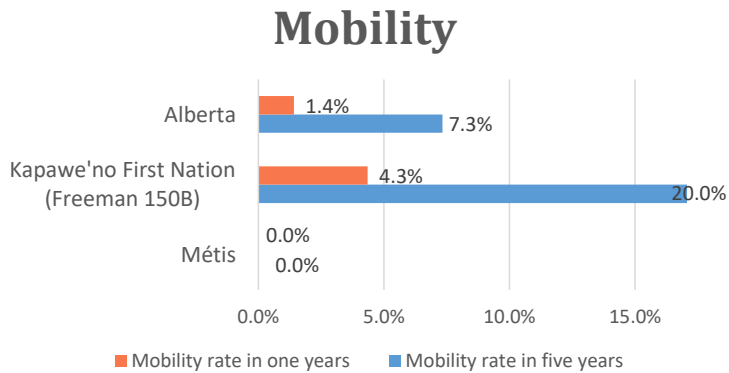
The total population reported with Métis single identity is 15 (Total Métis household is 10), representing 13% of Aboriginal people, accounting for 12.5% of the total population in Kapawe'no First Nation (Freeman 150B).



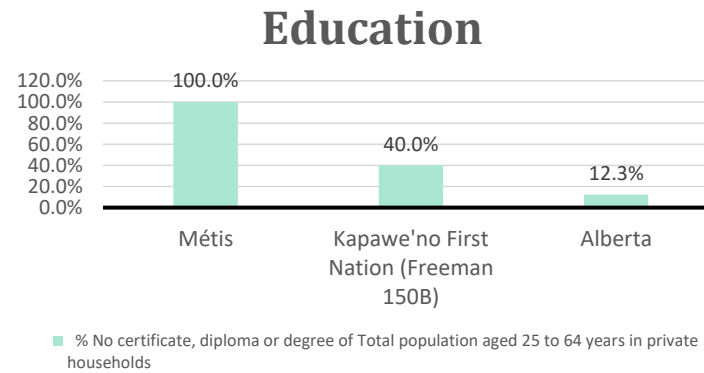
For Métis single identity population, the median age is 38.9 years old, with 100.0% of the population aged 15 and over. As for the total population, the median age is 23.8 in Kapawe'no First Nation (Freeman 150B) and 36.1 years old in Alberta, with 66.7% and 81.0% population aged 15 and over respectively.

No Métis households reported moving in for the last 5 years.

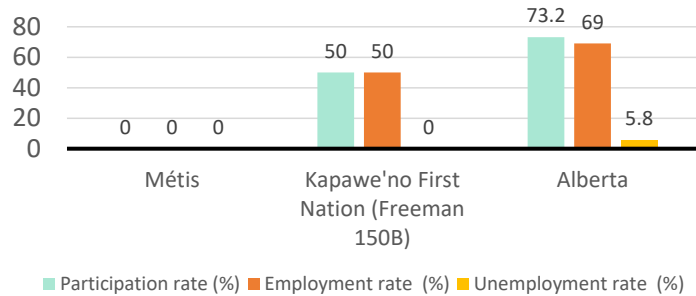

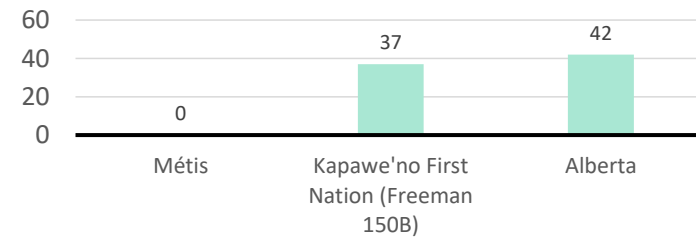

Labour Force Status



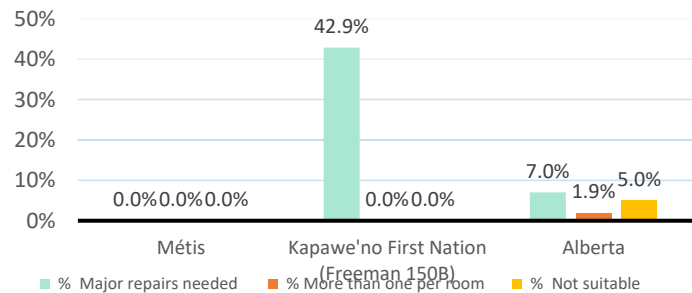

Average Weeks Worked in 2010



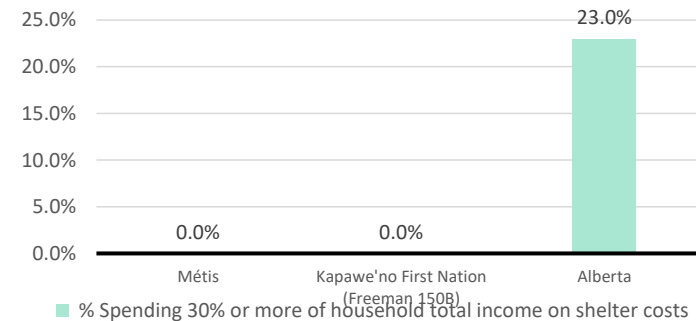

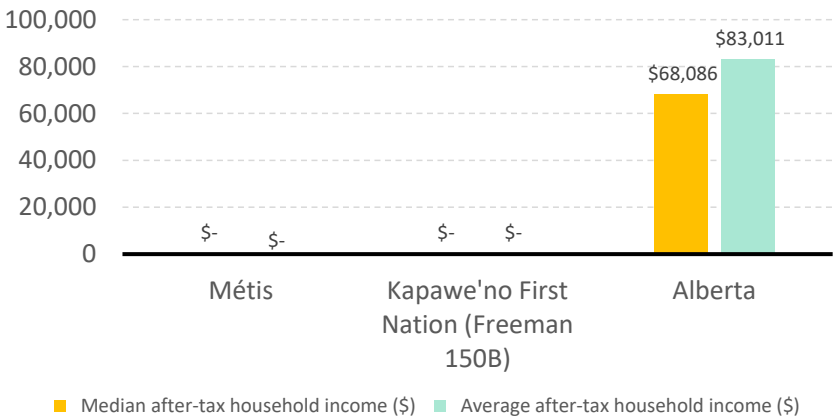

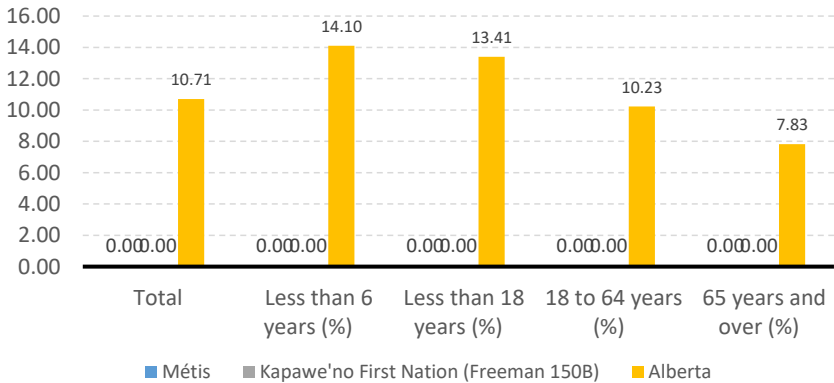
Income
