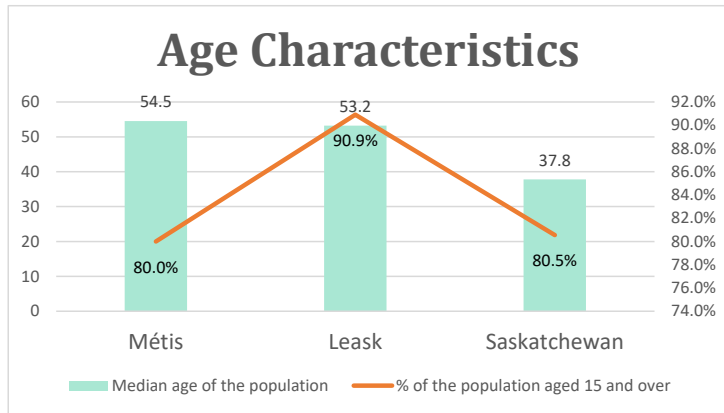

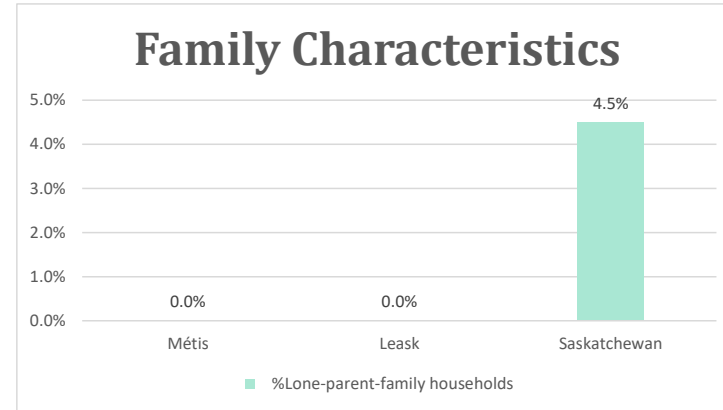

The total population reported with Métis single identity is 75 (Total Métis household is 50), representing 83% of Aboriginal people, accounting for 19.5% of the total population in Leask.

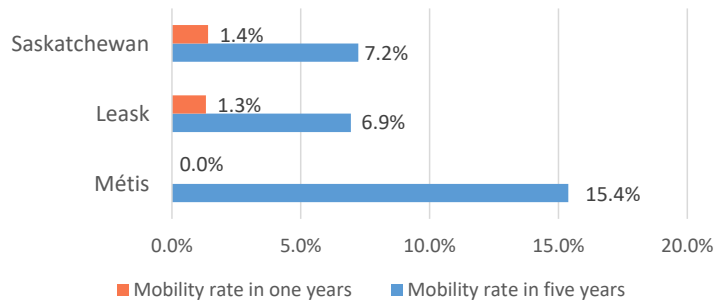


For Métis single identity population, the median age is 54.5 years old, with 80.0% of the population aged 15 and over. As for the total population, the median age is 53.2 in Leask and 37.8 years old in Saskatchewan, with 90.9% and 80.5% population aged 15 and over respectively.



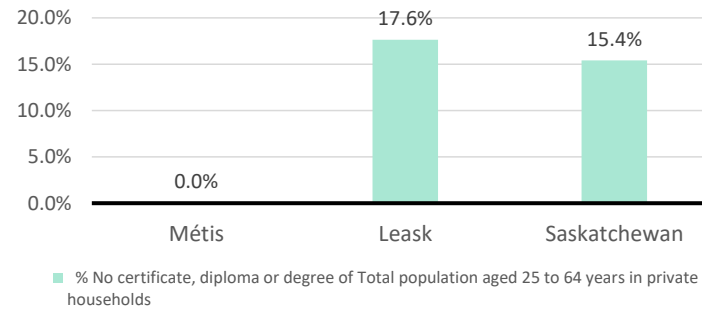
No Métis single lone parents household reported to the survey.

Education



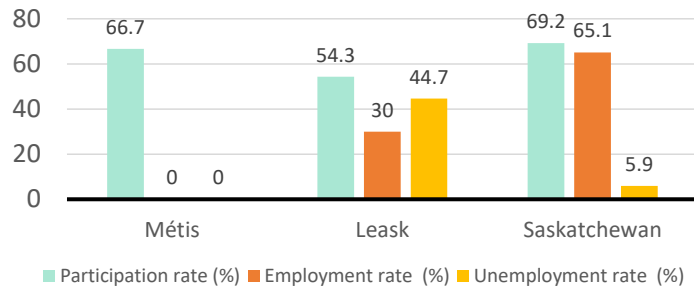
For population aged from 25 to 64 years, no Métis reported have no certificate, diploma or degree.

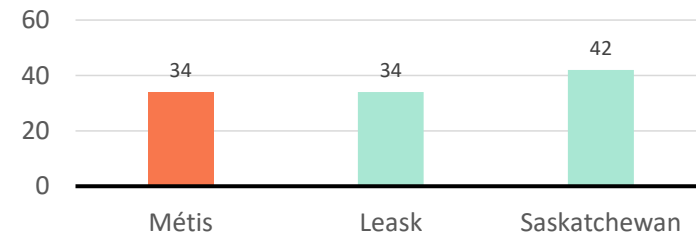

Labour Force Status



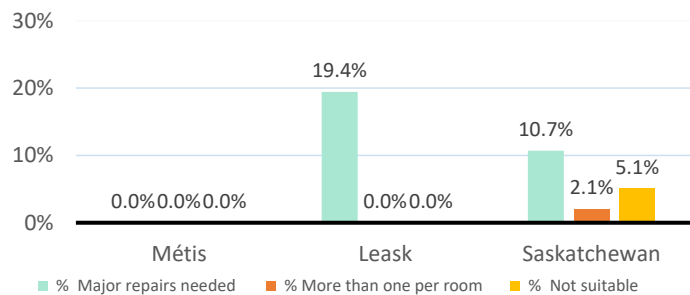
Métis participation rate is 66.7%, employment rate is 0.0%, and unemployment rate is 0.0%. While the participation rate is higher compared with total population in Leask and lower than Saskatchewan (54.3% and 69.2%), no Métis reported unemployment.

Average Weeks Worked in 2010



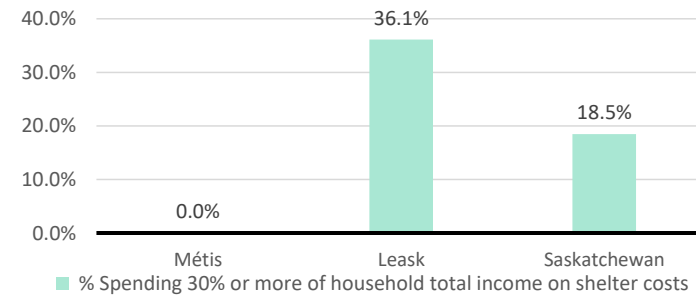
The average weeks worked in 2010 is 34.0 weeks.

Shelter Costs



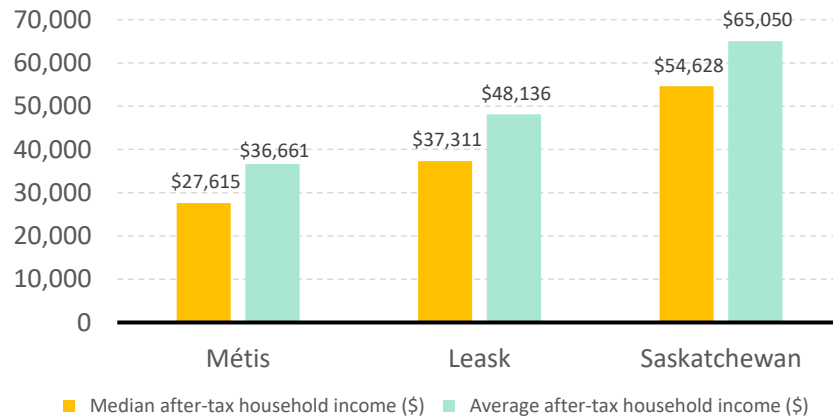
No Métis households reported spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs,

Income

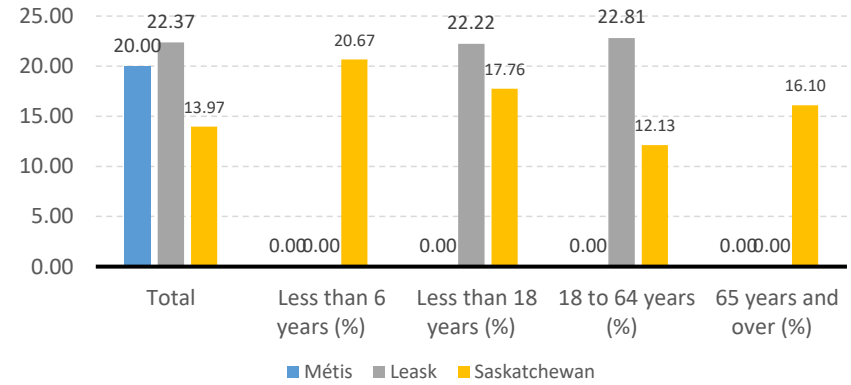
After-Tax Income of Households in 2010



For Métis singles, median after-tax household income is \$27,615, and average after-tax household income is

\$36,661. Métis has lower median and average after-tax income than Leask and Saskatchewan.
