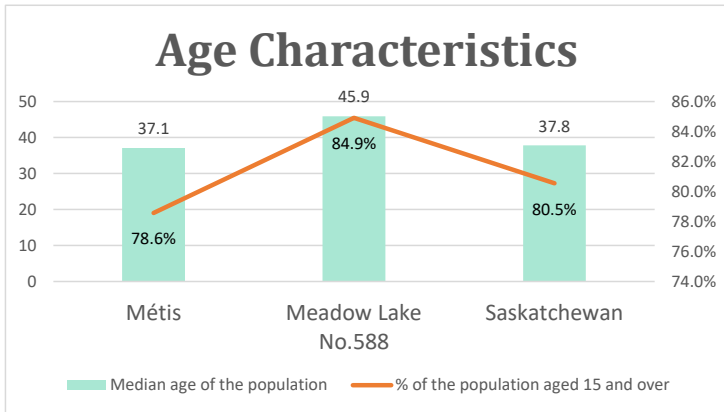


# Meadow Lake No.588, SK

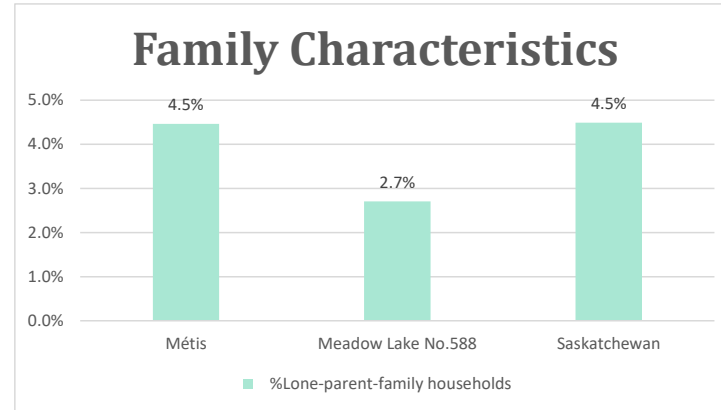

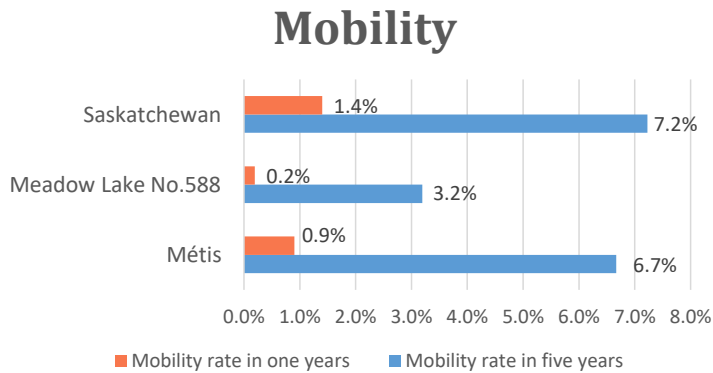
The total population reported with Métis single identity is 560 (Total Métis households 235), representing 70% of Aboriginal people, accounting for 21.7% of the total population in Meadow Lake No.588.



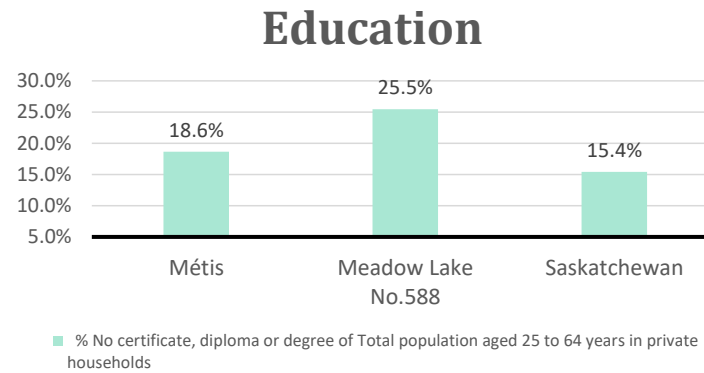
For Métis single identity population, the median age is 37.1 years old, with 78.6% of the population aged 15 and over. As for the total population, the median age is 45.9 in Meadow Lake No.588 and 37.8 years old in Saskatchewan, with 84.9% and 80.5% population aged 15 and over respectively.



The number of Métis single lone parents household is 25, accounting for 4.5% of the total Métis single private households.



5 Métis households moved in last year (0.9%), 35 Métis households moved in the past 5 years (6.7%).



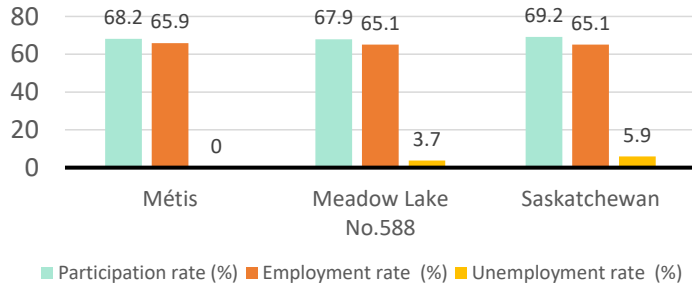
For population aged from 25 to 64 years, no Métis reported have no certificate, diploma or degree.

## Labor Force & Housing Statistics

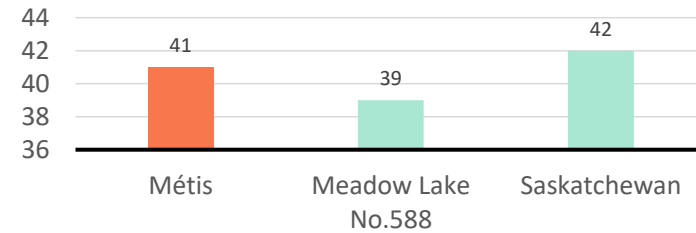
### Labour Force Status



Métis participation rate is 68.2%, employment rate is 65.9%, and unemployment rate is 0.0%.

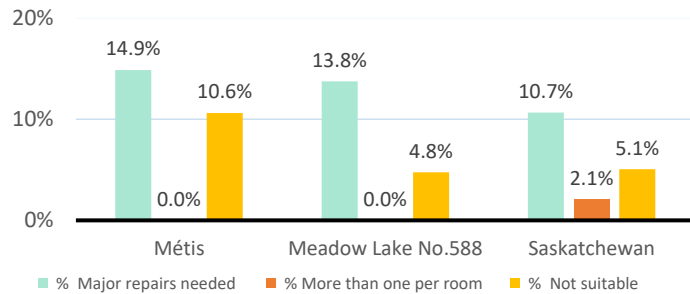
While the participation rate is higher compared with total population in Meadow Lake No.588 and lower than Saskatchewan (67.9% and 69.2%), no Métis reported unemployment.

### Average Weeks Worked in 2010



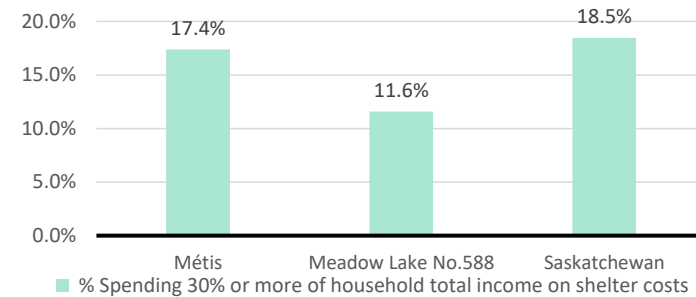
The average weeks worked in 2010 is 41.0 weeks.

### Household Characteristics



There are 235 private dwellings occupied by a Métis single household, out of which 14.9% need major repairs, no Métis household reported have more than one person per room, and 10.6% Métis household reported to be not suitable.

### Shelter Costs



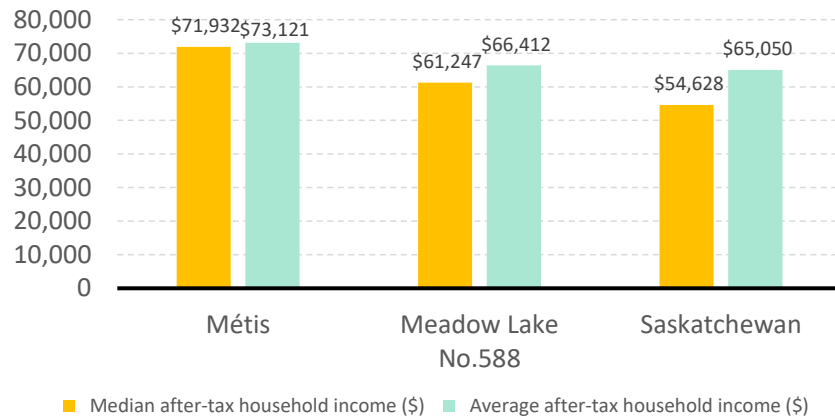
The number of Métis households spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs is 40,

of the total private dwellings occupied by a Métis household, compared to 11.6% of the total population in Meadow Lake No.588 and 18.5% of the total population in Saskatchewan.

## Income

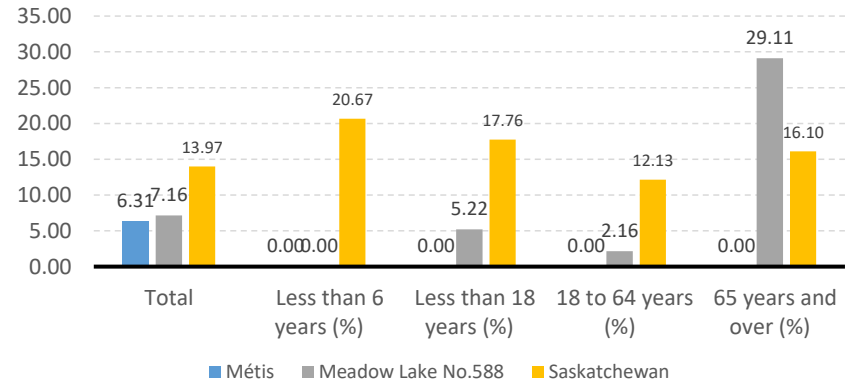
After-Tax Income of Households in 2010



For Métis singles, median after-tax household income is \$71,932, and average after-tax household income is

\$73,121. Métis has higher median and average after-tax income than Meadow Lake No.588 and Saskatchewan.

The prevalence of low income based on after-tax low-income measure is 6.31%.
