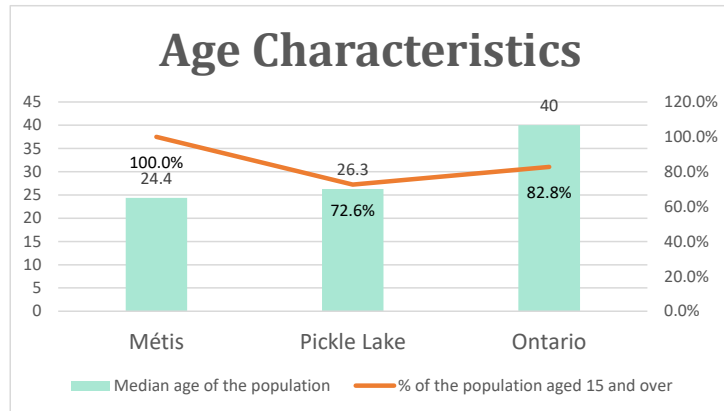


# Pickle Lake, ON

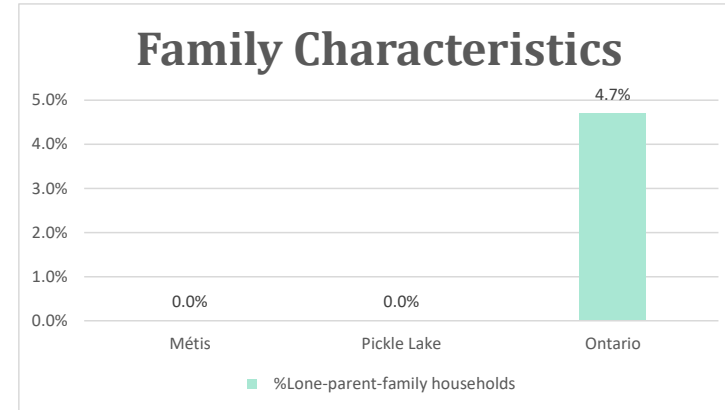

The total population reported with Métis single identity is 55 (Total Métis household is 30), representing 37% of Aboriginal people, accounting for 13.1% of the total population in Pickle Lake.

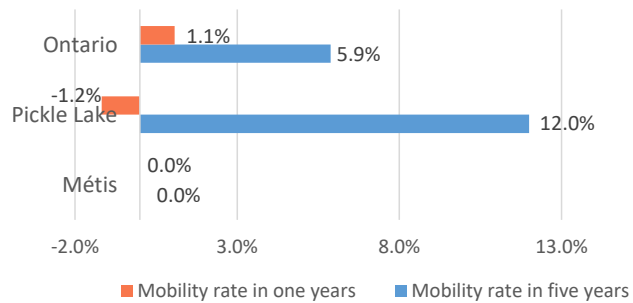


For Métis single identity population, the median age is 24.4 years old, with 100.0% of the population aged 15 and over. As for the total population, the median age is 26.3 in Pickle Lake and 40.0 years old in Ontario, with 72.6% and 82.8% population aged 15 and over respectively.



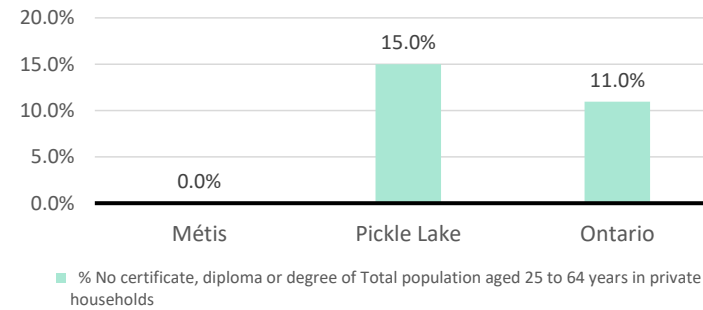
No Métis single lone parents household reported to the survey.

## Education



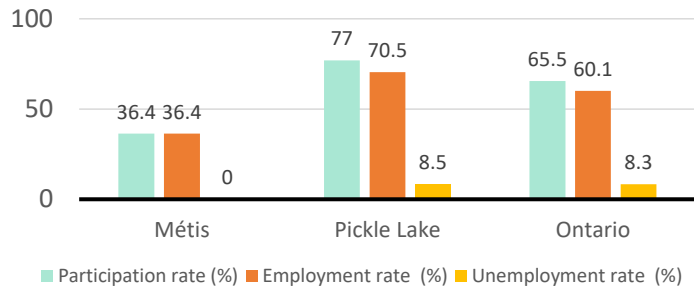
For population aged from 25 to 64 years, no Métis reported have no certificate, diploma or degree.

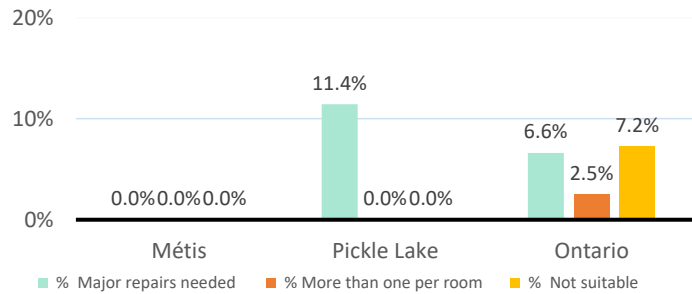
### Labour Force Status



Métis participation rate is 36.4%, employment rate is 36.4%, and unemployment rate is 0.0%.

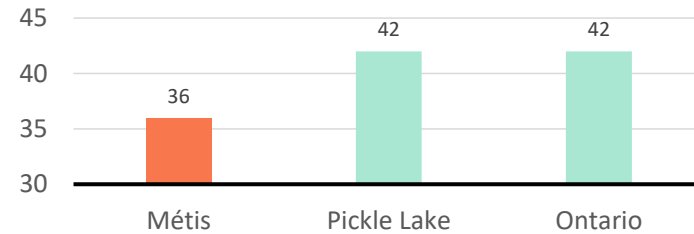
While the participation rate is lower compared with total population in Pickle Lake and Ontario (77.0% and 65.5%), no Métis reported unemployment.

### Household Characteristics



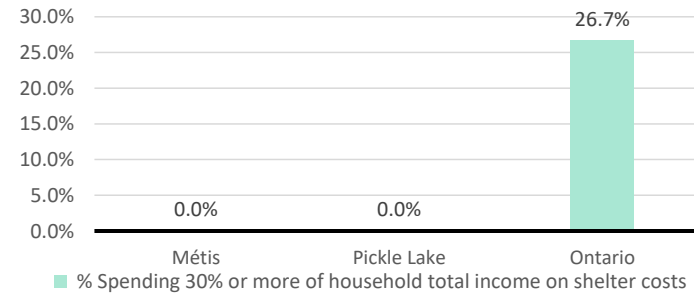
There are 30 private dwellings occupied by a Métis single household, out of which no Métis single household reported need major repairs, have more than one person per room, or not suitable.

### Shelter Costs



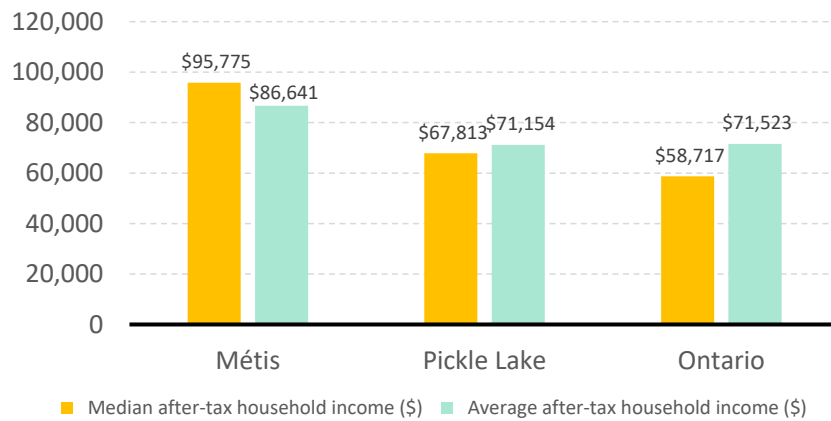
No Métis households reported spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs,

## Income

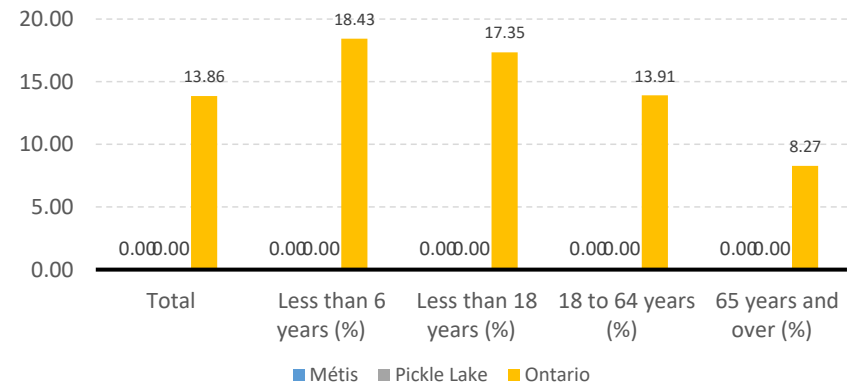
After-Tax Income of Households in 2010



For Métis singles, median after-tax household income is \$95,775, and average after-tax household income is

\$86,641. Métis has higher median and average after-tax income than Pickle Lake and Ontario.
