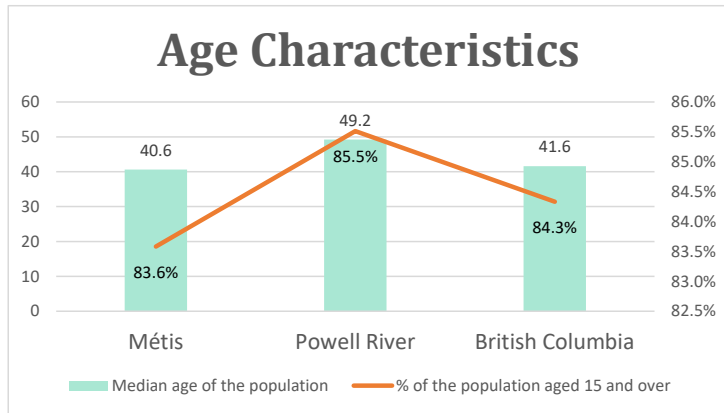

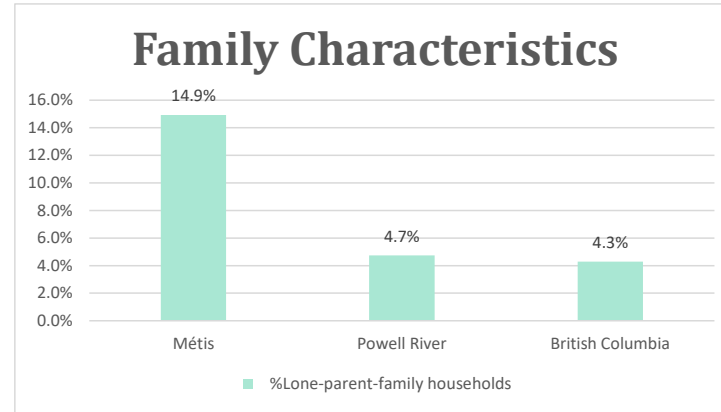

The total population reported with Métis single identity is 335 (Total Métis household is 185), representing 47% of Aboriginal people, accounting for 2.6% of the total population in Powell River.



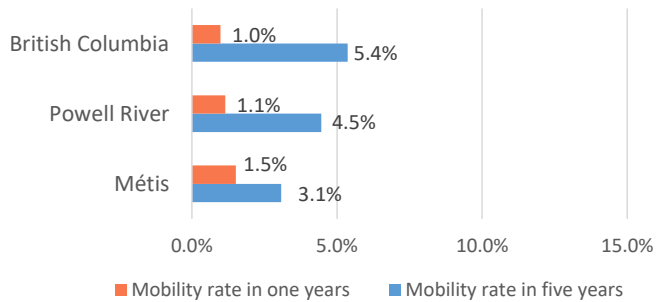
For Métis single identity population, the median age is 40.6 years old, with 83.6% of the population aged 15 and over. As for the total population, the median age is 49.2 in Powell River and

41.6 years old in British Columbia, with 85.5% and 84.3% population aged 15 and over respectively.



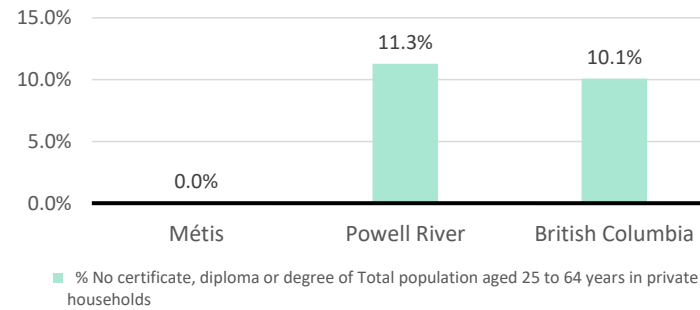
The number of Métis single lone parents household is 50, accounting for 14.9% of the total Métis single private households.

## Education



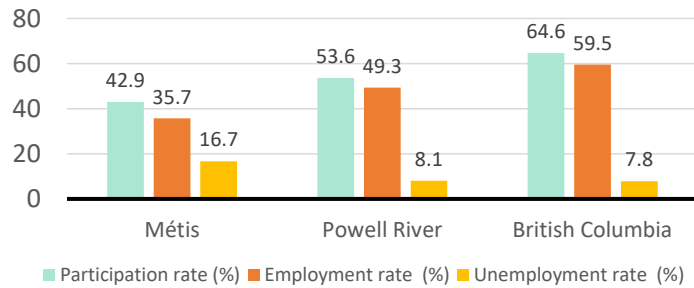
For population aged from 25 to 64 years, no Métis reported have no certificate, diploma or degree.

## Labor Force & Housing Statistics

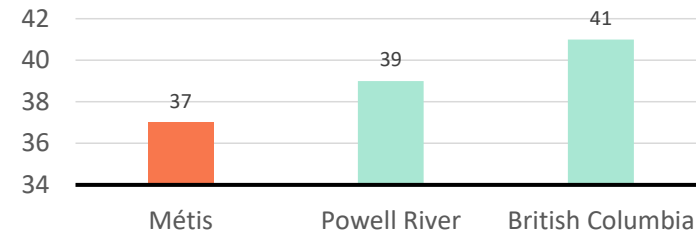
### Labour Force Status



Métis participation rate is 42.9%, employment rate is 35.7%, and unemployment rate is 16.7%.

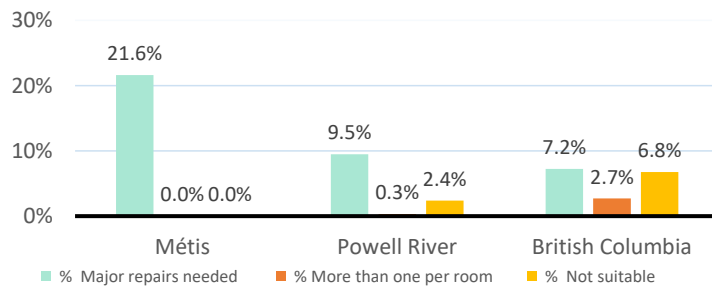
While the participation rate is lower compared with total population in Powell River and British Columbia (53.6% and 64.6%), unemployment rate is higher.

### Average Weeks Worked in 2010



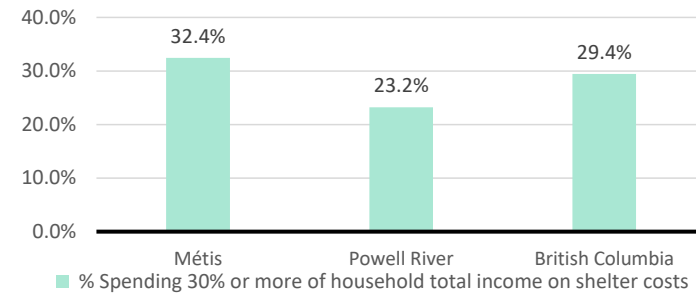
The average weeks worked in 2010 is 37.0 weeks.

### Household Characteristics



There are 185 private dwellings occupied by a Métis single household, out of which 21.6% need major repairs, no Métis household reported have more than one person per room, and no Métis household reported to be not suitable.

### Shelter Costs



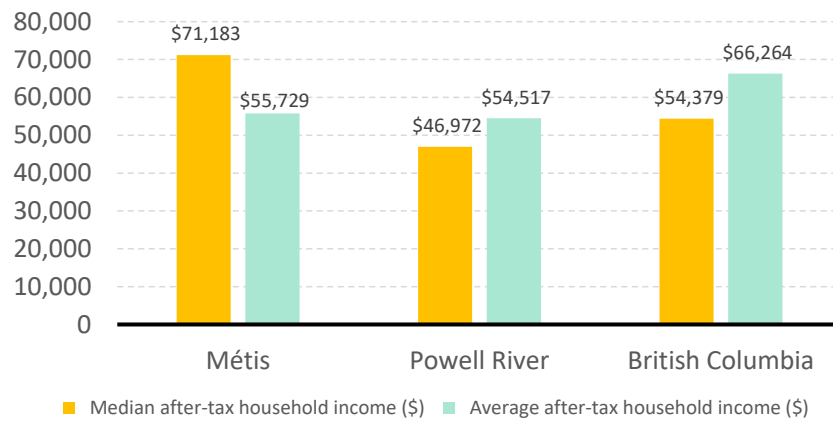
The number of Métis households spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs is 60, which is 32.4%

of the total private dwellings occupied by a Métis household, compared to 23.2% of the total population in Powell River and 29.4% of the total population in British Columbia.

## Income

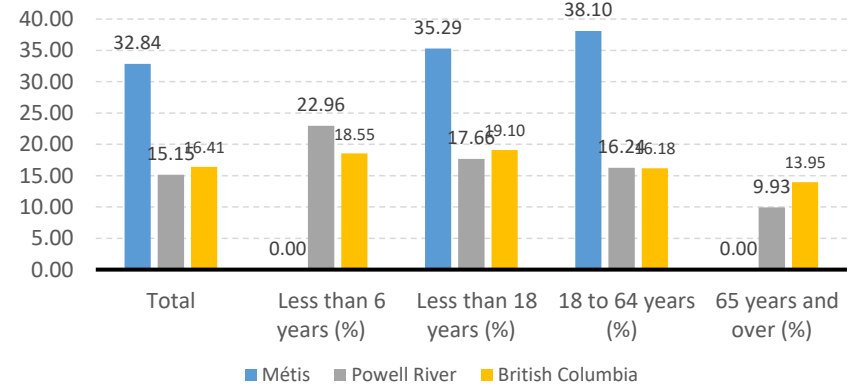
After-Tax Income of Households in 2010



For Métis singles, median after-tax household income is \$71,183, and average after-tax household income is

\$55,729. Métis has higher median and average after-tax income than Powell River, and higher median and lower average after-tax income than British Columbia.

Prevalence of Low Income in 2010 Based On After-Tax Low-Income Measure (%)



The prevalence of low income based on after-tax low-income measure is 32.84%.

The percentage of low income is 35.29% for people less than 18 years old, 0.00% for people less than 6 years old, 38.10% for people from 18 to 64 years old, and 0.00% for people over 65 years old.
