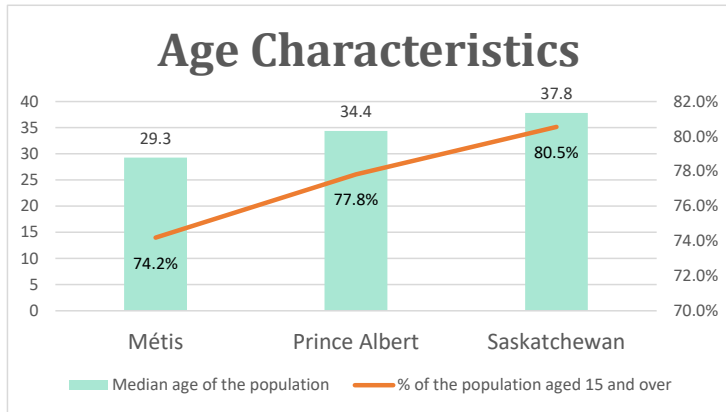

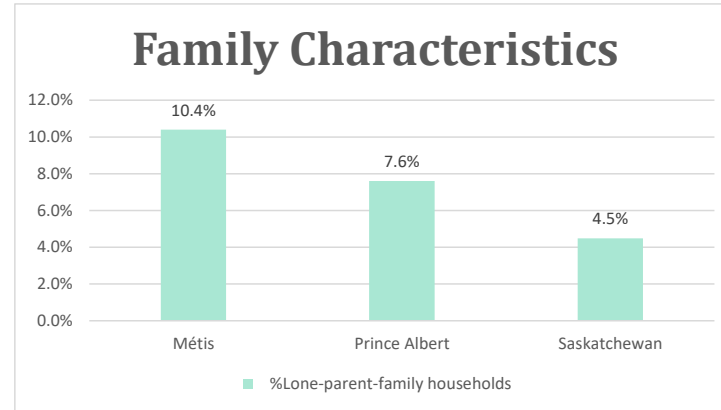

The total population reported with Métis single identity is 6,685 (Total Métis household is 3,450), representing 48% of Aboriginal people, accounting for 19.5% of the total population in Prince Albert.

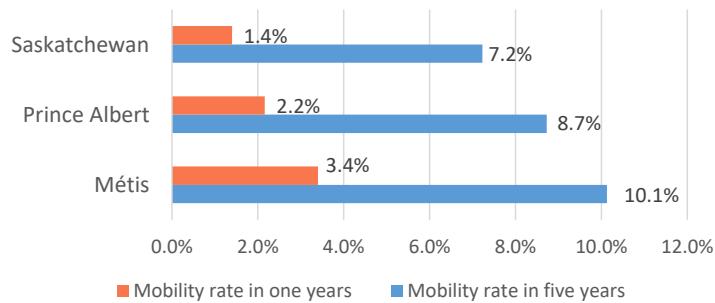


For Métis single identity population, the median age is 29.3 years old, with 74.2% of the population aged 15 and over. As for the total population, the median age is 34.4 in Prince Albert and 37.8 years old in Saskatchewan, with 77.8% and 80.5% population aged 15 and over respectively.



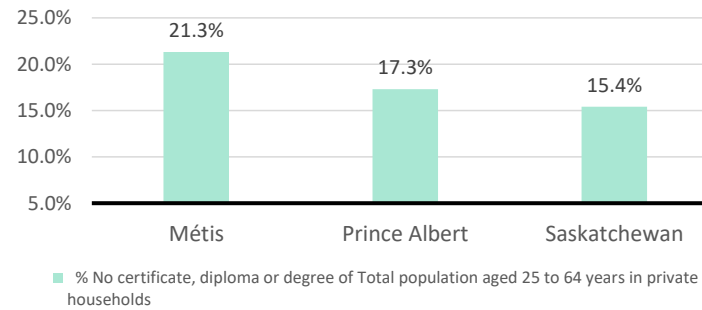
The number of Métis single lone parents household is 695, accounting for 10.4% of the total Métis single private households.

220 Métis households moved in last year (3.4%), 615 Métis households moved in the past 5 years (10.1%).

Education



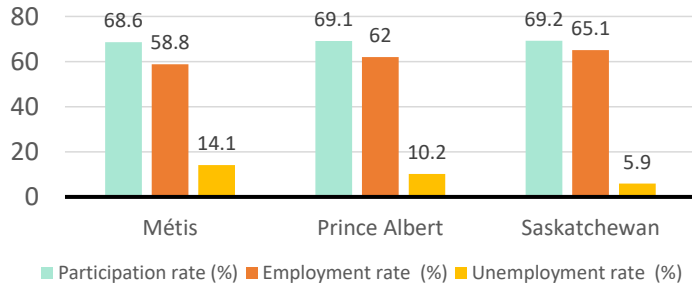
For population aged from 25 to 64 years, 21.3% Métis compared to 17.3% in Prince Albert and 15.4% in Saskatchewan have no certificate, diploma or degree.

For Métis aged from 25 to 34, 14.2% Métis reported to have no certificate, diploma or degree.

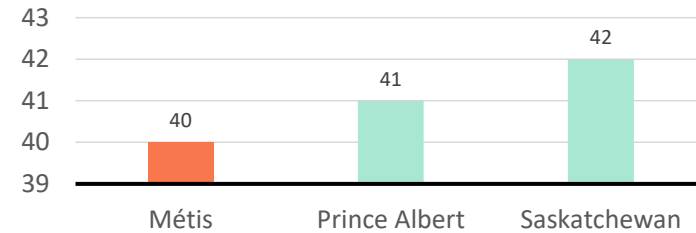
Labour Force Status



Métis participation rate is 68.6%, employment rate is 58.8%, and unemployment rate is 14.1%.

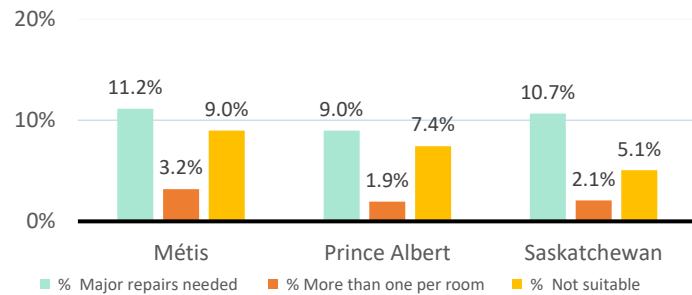
While the participation rate is lower compared with total population in Prince Albert and Saskatchewan (69.1% and 69.2%), unemployment rate is higher.

Average Weeks Worked in 2010



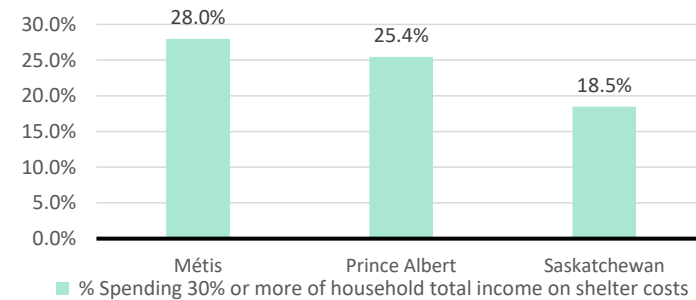
The average weeks worked in 2010 is 40.0 weeks.

Household Characteristics



There are 3450 private dwellings occupied by a Métis single household, out of which 11.2% need major repairs, 3.2% have more than one person per room, and 9.0% Métis household reported to be not suitable.

Shelter Costs



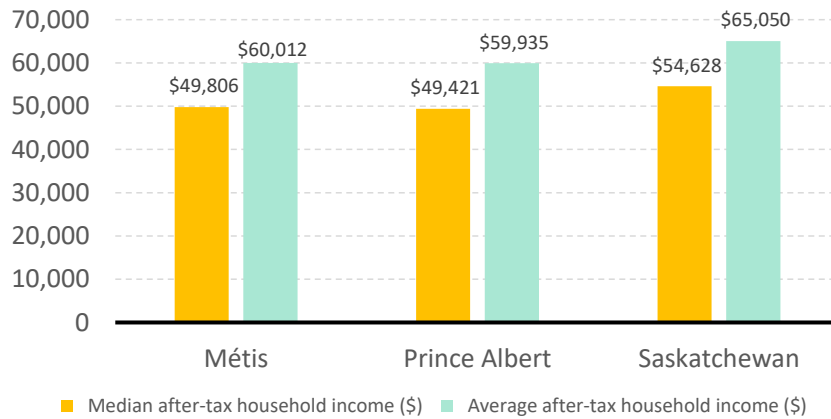
The number of Métis households spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs is 965, which is 28.0%

of the total private dwellings occupied by a Métis household, compared to 25.4% of the total population in Prince Albert and 18.5% of the total population in Saskatchewan.

Income

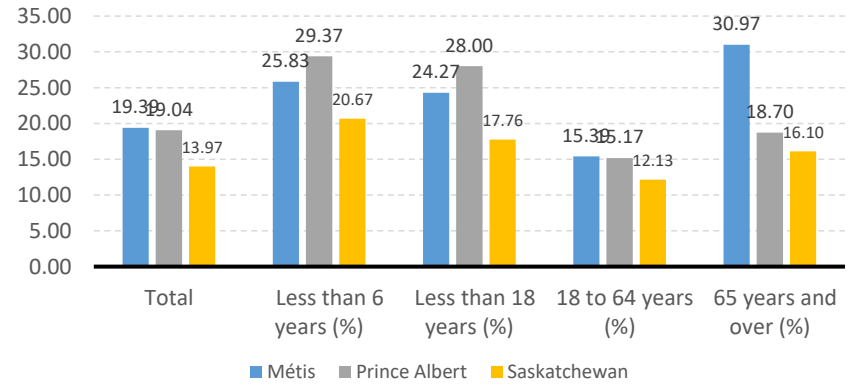
After-Tax Income of Households in 2010



For Métis singles, median after-tax household income is \$49,806, and average after-tax household income is

\$60,012. Métis has higher median and average after-tax income than Prince Albert, and lower median and average after-tax income than Saskatchewan.

Prevalence of Low Income in 2010 Based On After-Tax Low-Income Measure (%)



The prevalence of low income based on after-tax low-income measure is 19.39%.

The percentage of low income is 24.27% for people less than 18 years old, 25.83% for people less than 6 years old, 15.39% for people from 18 to 64 years old, and 30.97% for people over 65 years old.
