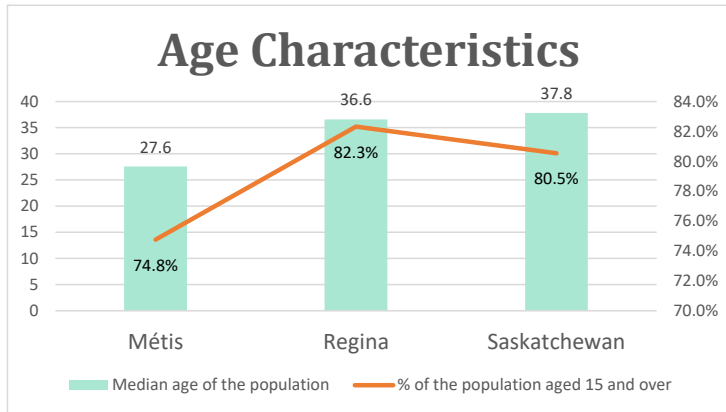

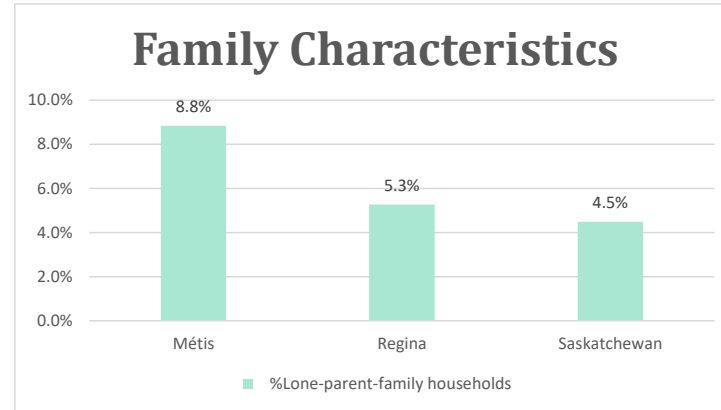

The total population reported with Métis single identity is 7,410 (Total Métis household is 4,195), representing 40% of Aboriginal people, accounting for 3.9% of the total population in Regina.

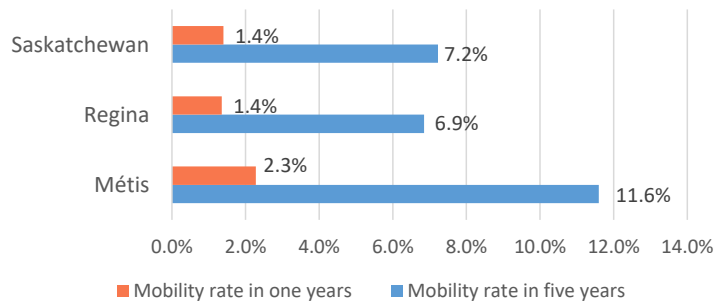


For Métis single identity population, the median age is 27.6 years old, with 74.8% of the population aged 15 and over. As for the total population, the median age is 36.6 in Regina and 37.8 years old in Saskatchewan, with 82.3% and 80.5% population aged 15 and over respectively.



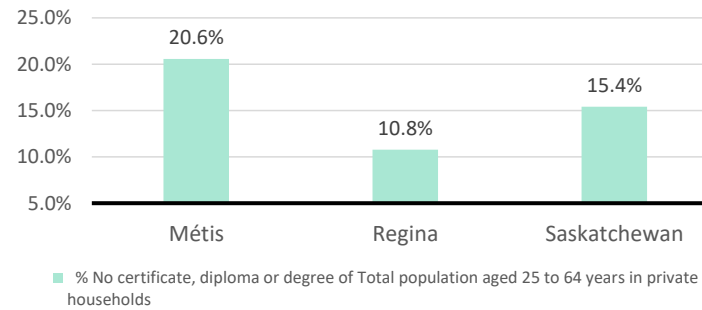
The number of Métis single lone parents household is 655, accounting for 8.8% of the total Métis single private households.

165 Métis households moved in last year (2.3%), 770 Métis households moved in the past 5 years (11.6%).

Education



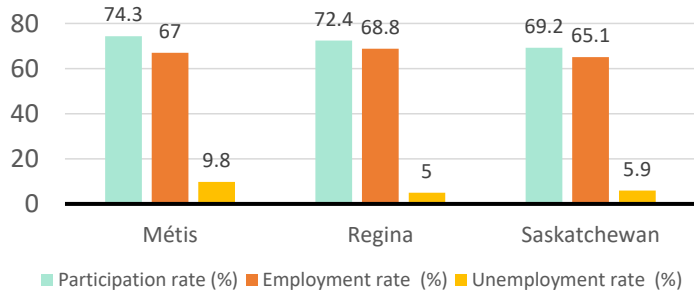
For population aged from 25 to 64 years, 20.6% Métis compared to 10.8% in Regina and 15.4% in Saskatchewan have no certificate, diploma or degree.

For Métis aged from 25 to 34, 24.5% Métis reported to have no certificate, diploma or degree.

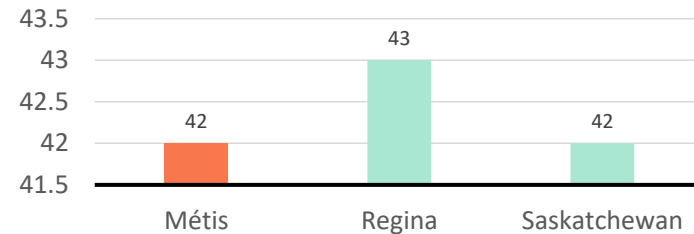
Labour Force Status



Métis participation rate is 74.3%, employment rate is 67.0%, and unemployment rate is 9.8%.

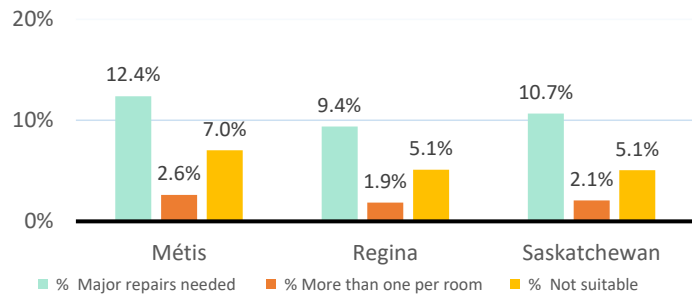
While the participation rate is higher compared with total population in Regina and Saskatchewan (72.4% and 69.2%), unemployment rate is also higher.

Average Weeks Worked in 2010



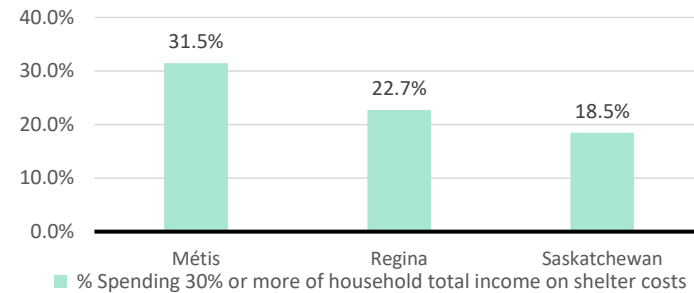
The average weeks worked in 2010 is 42.0 weeks.

Household Characteristics



There are 4195 private dwellings occupied by a Métis single household, out of which 12.4% need major repairs, 2.6% have more than one person per room, and 7.0% Métis household reported to be not suitable.

Shelter Costs



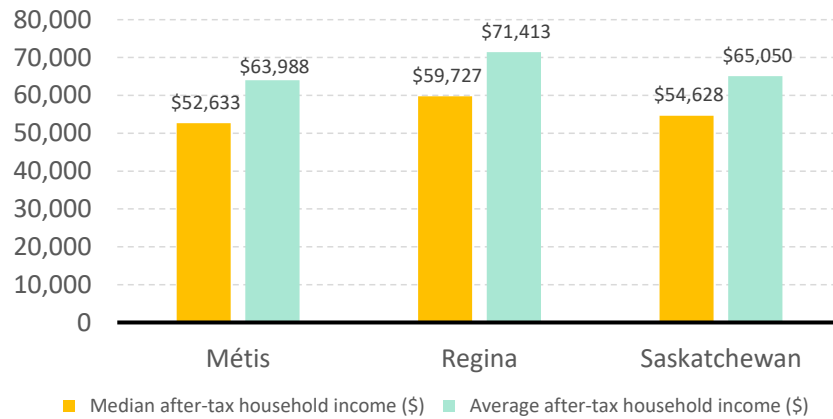
The number of Métis households spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs is 1320, which is 31.5%

of the total private dwellings occupied by a Métis household, compared to 22.7% of the total population in Regina and 18.5% of the total population in Saskatchewan.

Income

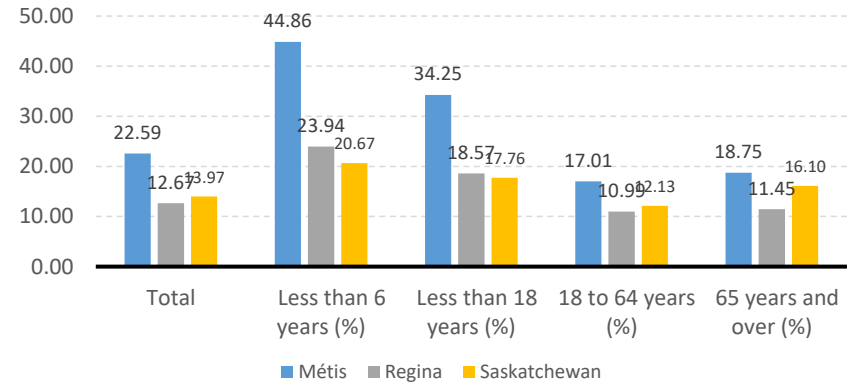
After-Tax Income of Households in 2010



For Métis singles, median after-tax household income is \$52,633, and average after-tax household income is

\$63,988. Métis has lower median and average after-tax income than Regina and Saskatchewan.

Prevalence of Low Income in 2010 Based On After-Tax Low-Income Measure (%)



The prevalence of low income based on after-tax low-income measure is 22.59%.

The percentage of low income is 34.25% for people less than 18 years old, 44.86% for people less than 6 years old, 17.01% for people from 18 to 64 years old, and 18.75% for people over 65 years old.
