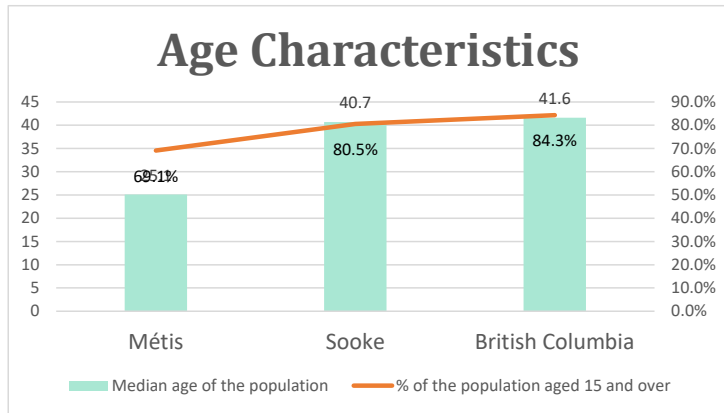

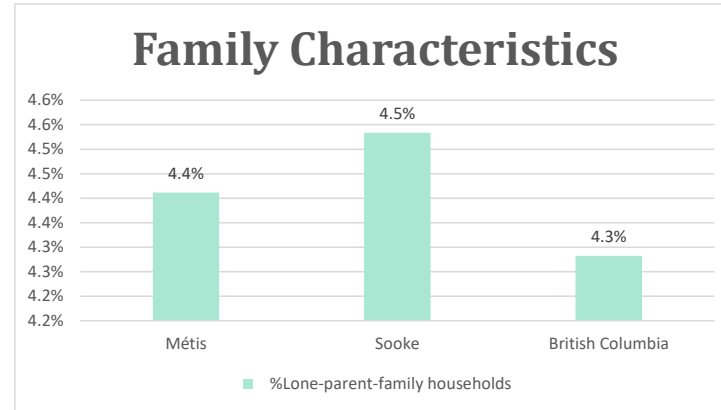

The total population reported with Métis single identity is 340 (Total Métis household is 185), representing 52% of Aboriginal people, accounting for 3.0% of the total population in Sooke.

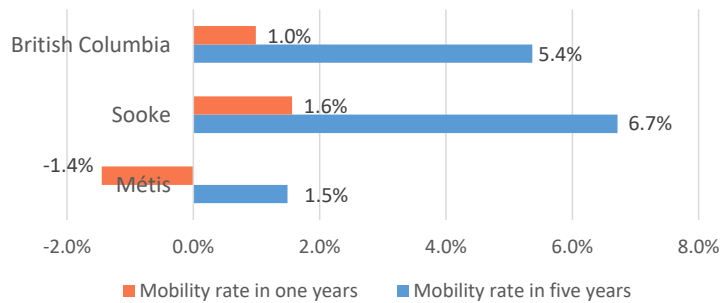


For Métis single identity population, the median age is 25.1 years old, with 69.1% of the population aged 15 and over. As for the total population, the median age is 40.7 in Sooke and 41.6 years old in British Columbia, with 80.5% and 84.3% population aged 15 and over respectively.



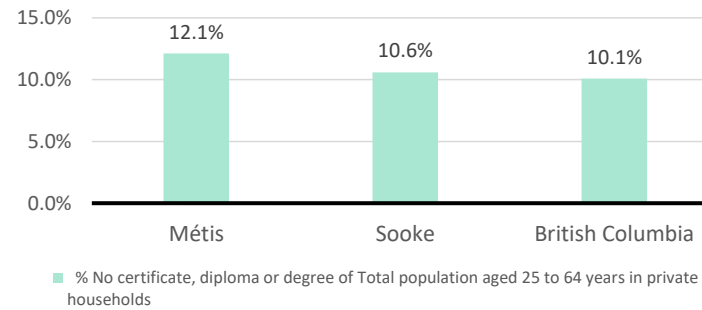
The number of Métis single lone parents household is 15, accounting for 4.4% of the total Métis single private households.

Education



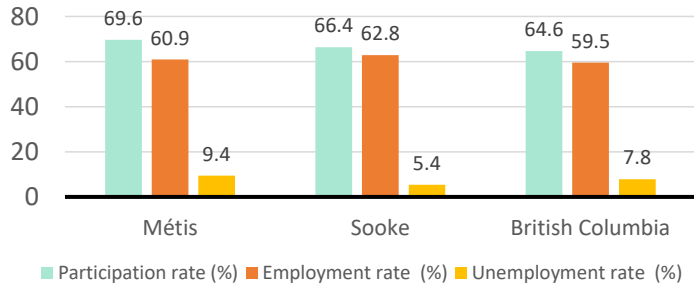

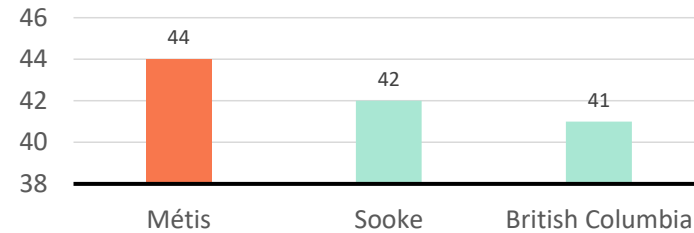
Labour Force Status



Métis participation rate is 69.6%, employment rate is 60.9%, and unemployment rate is 9.4%.

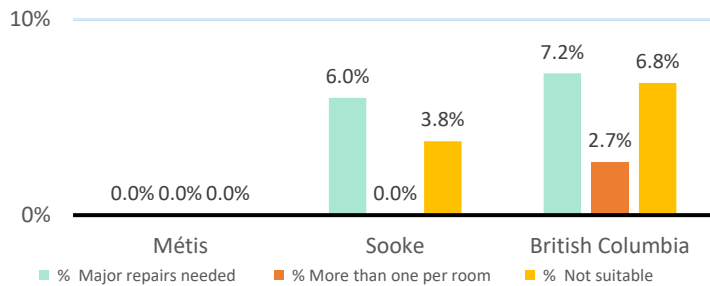
While the participation rate is higher compared with total population in Sooke and British Columbia (66.4% and 64.6%), unemployment rate is also higher.

Average Weeks Worked in 2010



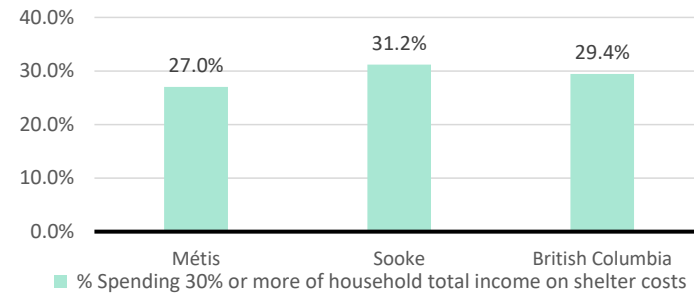
The average weeks worked in 2010 is 44.0 weeks.

Household Characteristics



There are 185 private dwellings occupied by a Métis single household, out of which no Métis single household reported need major repairs, have more than one person per room, or not suitable.

Shelter Costs



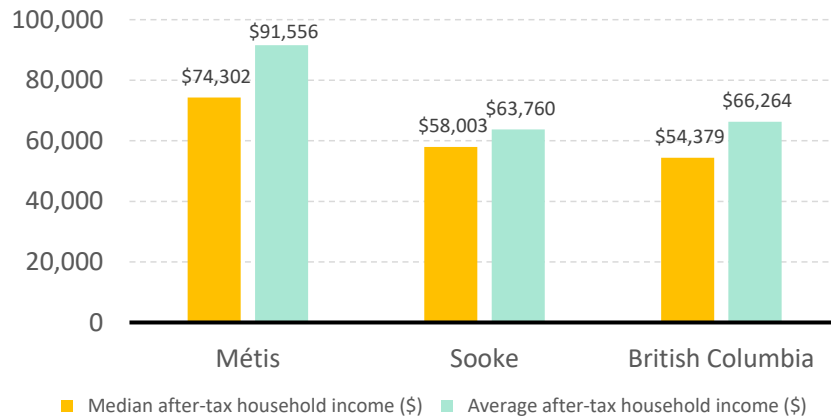
The number of Métis households spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs is 50, which is 27.0%

of the total private dwellings occupied by a Métis household, compared to 31.2% of the total population in Sooke and 29.4% of the total population in British Columbia.

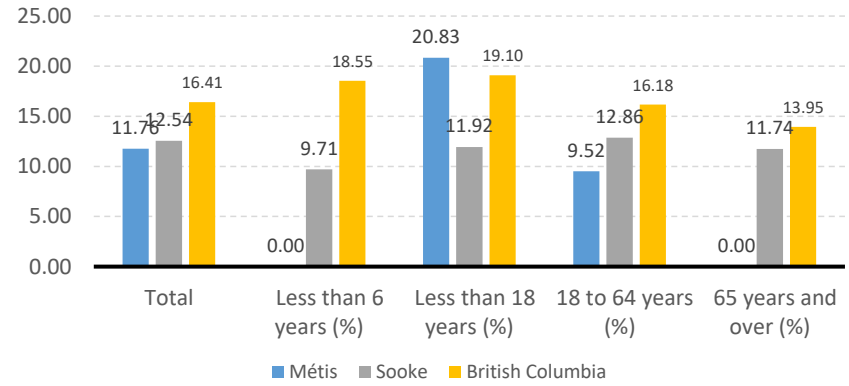
After-Tax Income of Households in 2010



For Métis singles, median after-tax household income is \$74,302, and average after-tax household income is

\$91,556. Métis has higher median and average after-tax income than Sooke and British Columbia.

Prevalence of Low Income in 2010 Based On After-Tax Low-Income Measure (%)



The prevalence of low income based on after-tax low-income measure is 11.76%.

The percentage of low income is 20.83% for people less than 18 years old, 0.00% for people less than 6 years old, 9.52% for people from 18 to 64 years old, and 0.00% for people over 65 years old.
