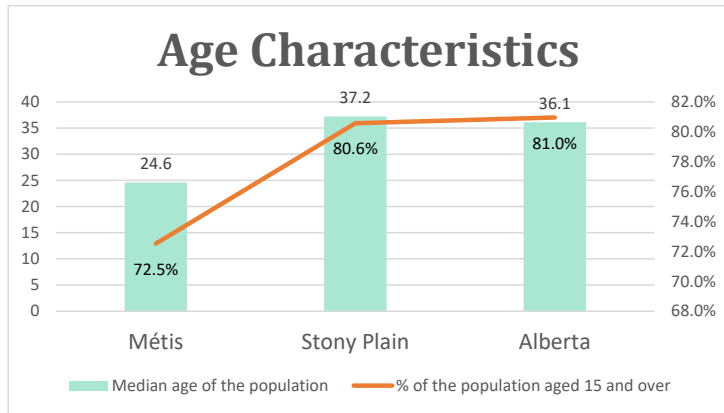


Stony Plain, AB

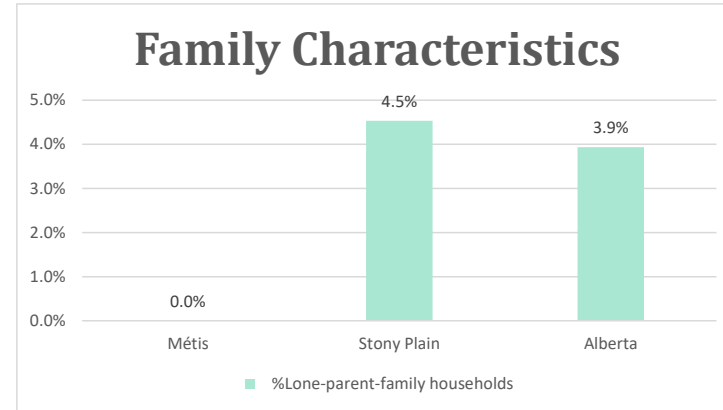

The total population reported with Métis single identity is 455 (Total Métis household is 240), representing 49% of Aboriginal people, accounting for 3.1% of the total population in Stony Plain.

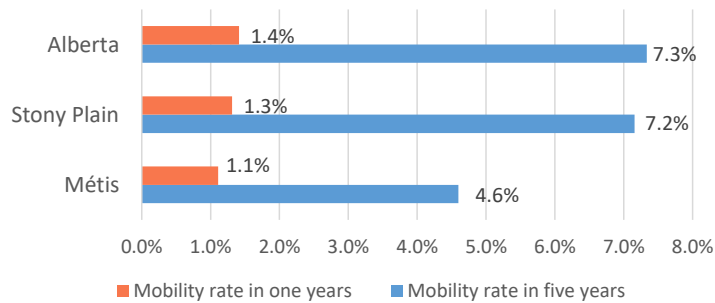


For Métis single identity population, the median age is 24.6 years old, with 72.5% of the population aged 15 and over. As for the total population, the median age is 37.2 in Stony Plain and 36.1 years old in Alberta, with 80.6% and 81.0% population aged 15 and over respectively.



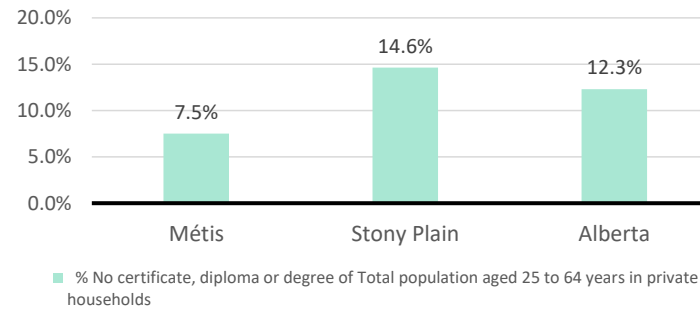
No Métis single lone parents household reported to the survey.

Education



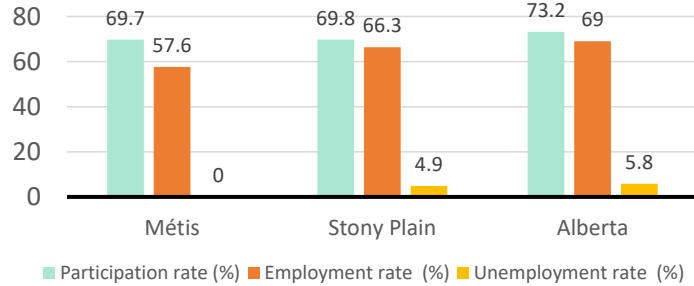

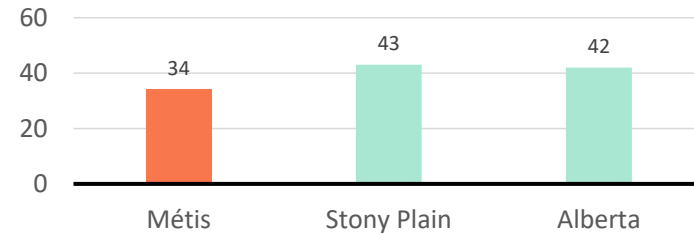
Labour Force Status



Métis participation rate is 69.7%, employment rate is 57.6%, and unemployment rate is 0.0%.

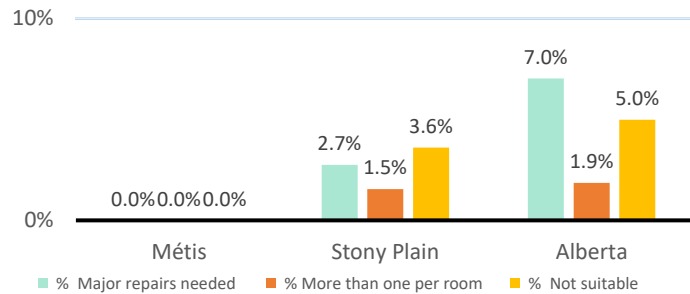
While the participation rate is lower compared with total population in Stony Plain and Alberta (69.8% and 73.2%), no Métis reported unemployment.

Average Weeks Worked in 2010



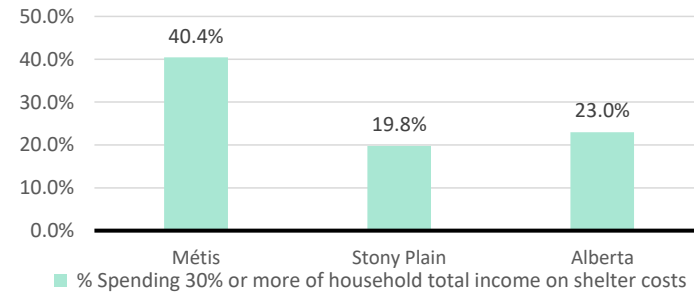
The average weeks worked in 2010 is 34.0 weeks.

Household Characteristics



There are 240 private dwellings occupied by a Métis single household, out of which no Métis single household reported need major repairs, have more than one person per room, or not suitable.

Shelter Costs



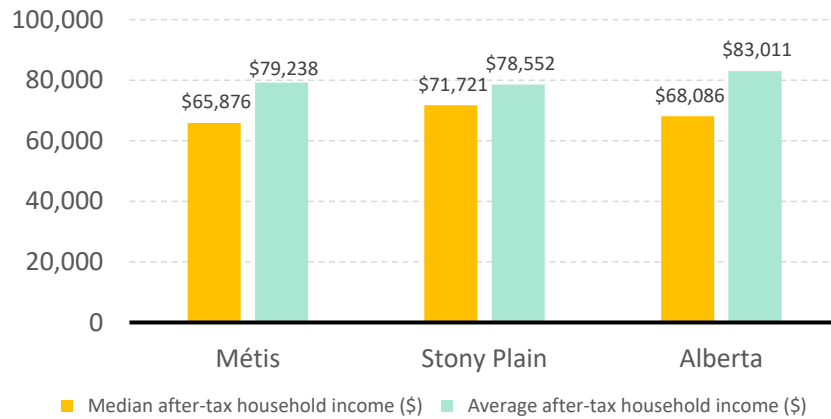
The number of Métis households spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs is 95, which is 40.4%

of the total private dwellings occupied by a Métis household, compared to 19.8% of the total population in Stony Plain and 23.0% of the total population in Alberta.

Income

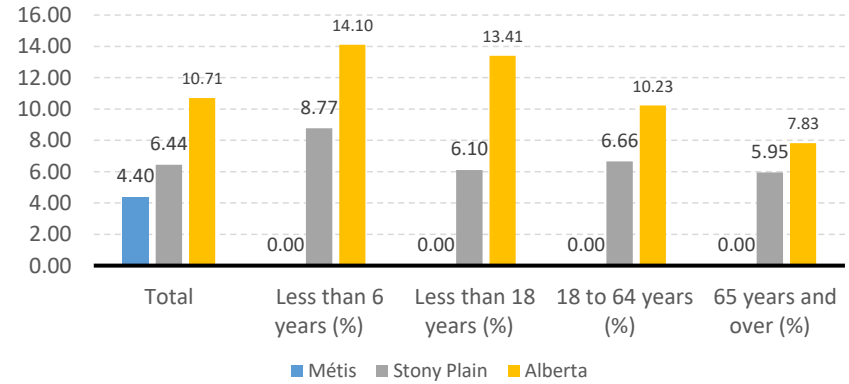
After-Tax Income of Households in 2010



For Métis singles, median after-tax household income is \$65,876, and average after-tax household income is

\$79,238. Métis has lower median and higher average after-tax income than Stony Plain, and lower median and average after-tax income than Alberta.

Prevalence of Low Income in 2010 Based On After-Tax Low-Income Measure (%)



The prevalence of low income based on after-tax low-income measure is 4.40%.
