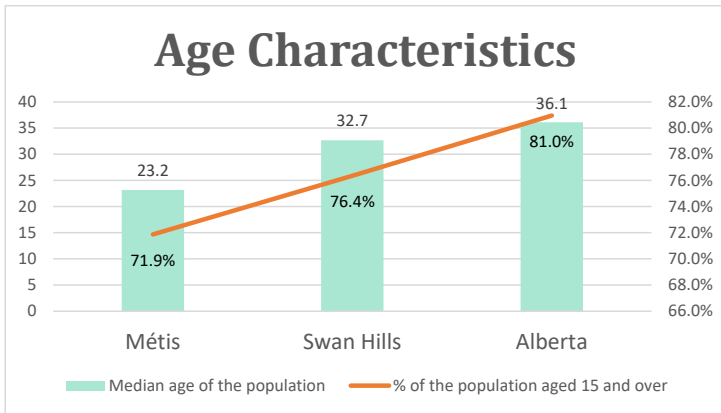


# Swan Hills, AB

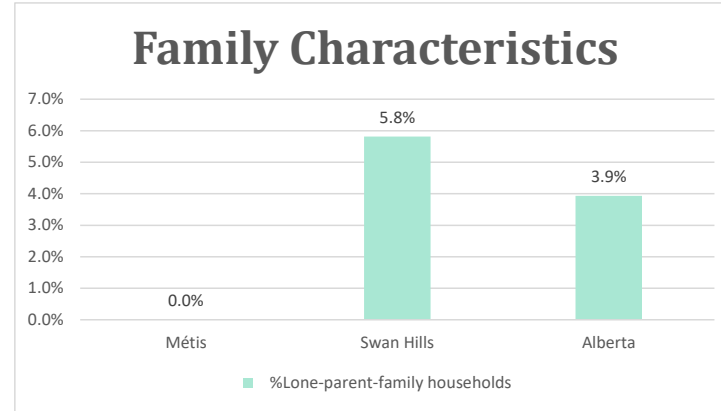

The total population reported with Métis single identity is 160 (Total Métis household is 75), representing 70% of Aboriginal people, accounting for 11.6% of the total population in Swan Hills.



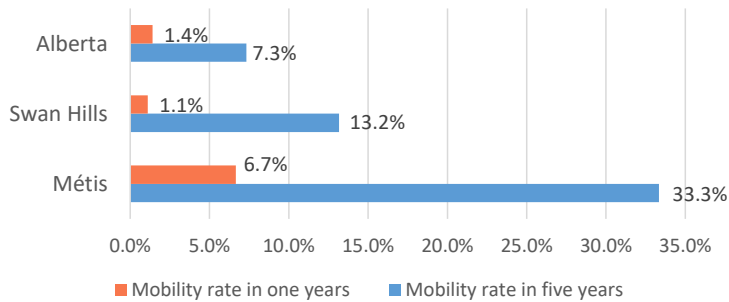
For Métis single identity population, the median age is 23.2 years old, with 71.9% of the population aged 15 and over. As for the total population, the median age is 32.7 in Swan Hills and

36.1 years old in Alberta, with 76.4% and 81.0% population aged 15 and over respectively.



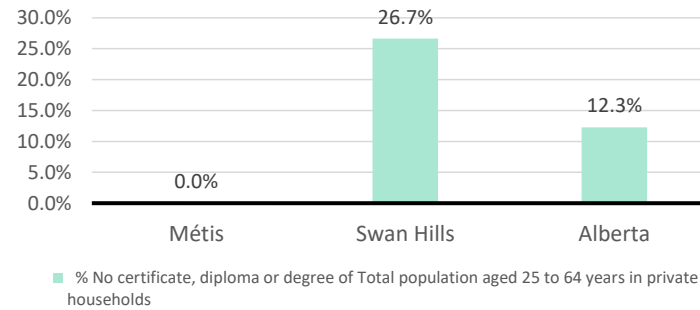
No Métis single lone parents household reported to the survey.

## Education



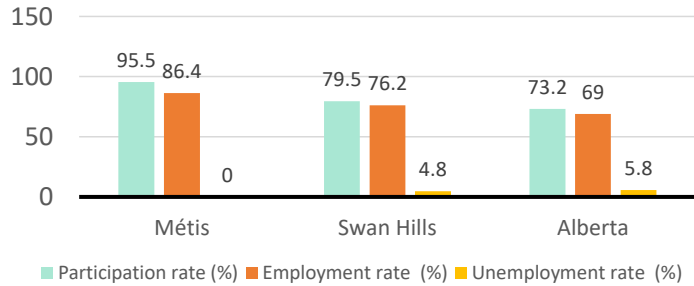
For population aged from 25 to 64 years, no Métis reported have no certificate, diploma or degree.

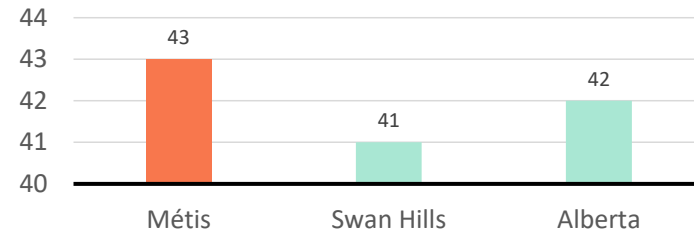
### Labour Force Status



Métis participation rate is 95.5%, employment rate is 86.4%, and unemployment rate is 0.0%.

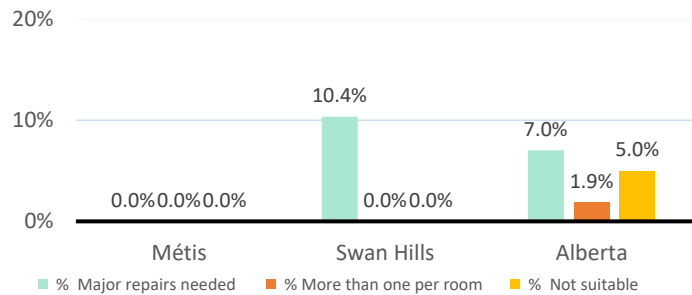
While the participation rate is higher compared with total population in Swan Hills and Alberta (79.5% and 73.2%), no Métis reported unemployment.

### Average Weeks Worked in 2010



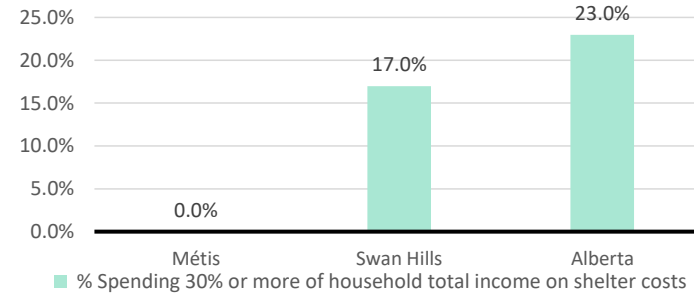
The average weeks worked in 2010 is 43.0 weeks.

### Shelter Costs



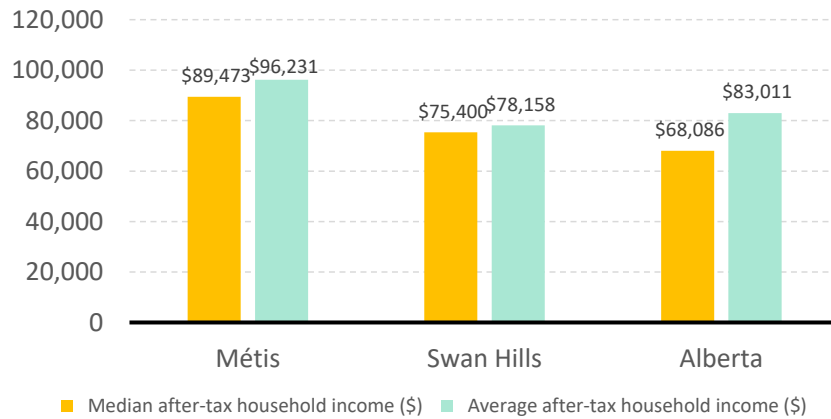
No Métis households reported spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs,

## Income

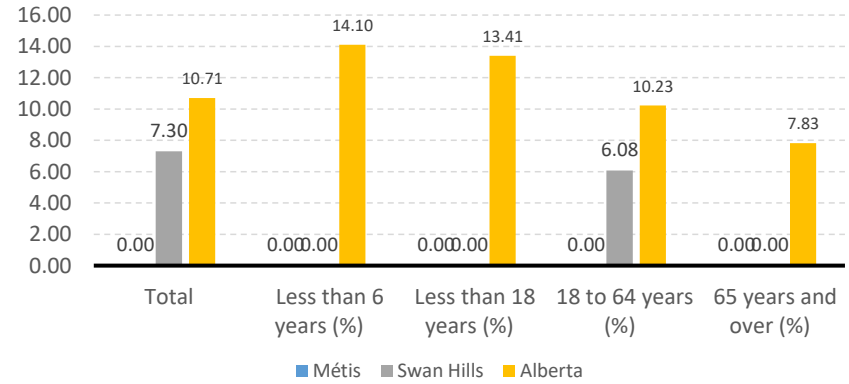
After-Tax Income of Households in 2010



For Métis singles, median after-tax household income is \$89,473, and average after-tax household income is

\$96,231. Métis has higher median and average after-tax income than Swan Hills and Alberta.
