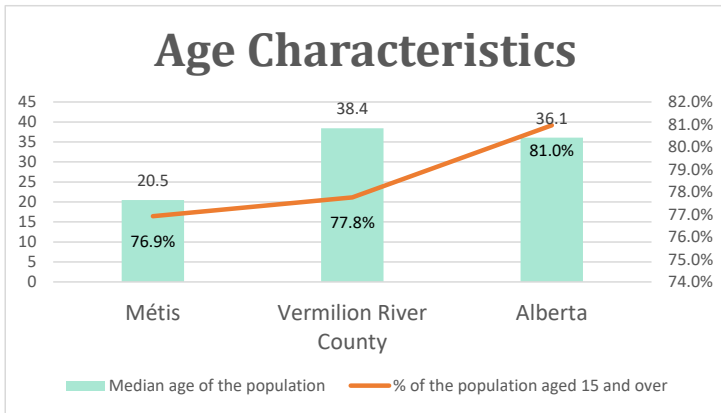


# Vermilion River County, AB

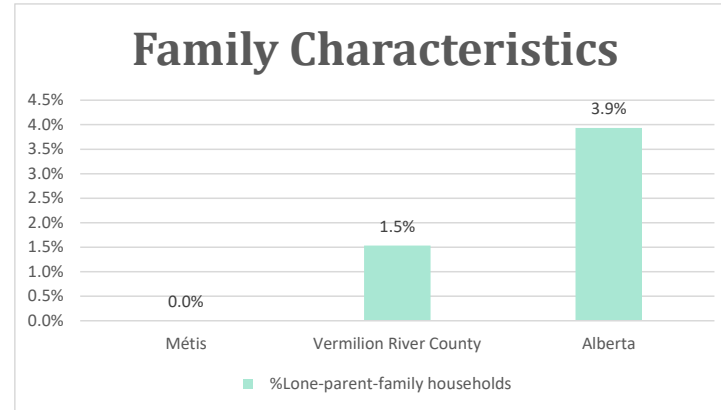

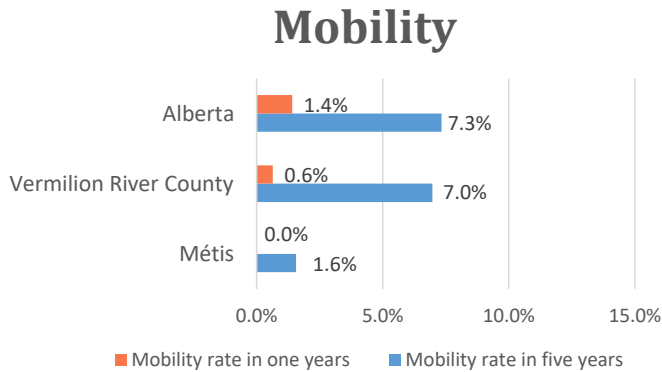
The total population reported with Métis single identity is 325 (Total Métis household is 130), representing 97% of Aboriginal people, accounting for 4.2% of the total population in Vermilion River County.



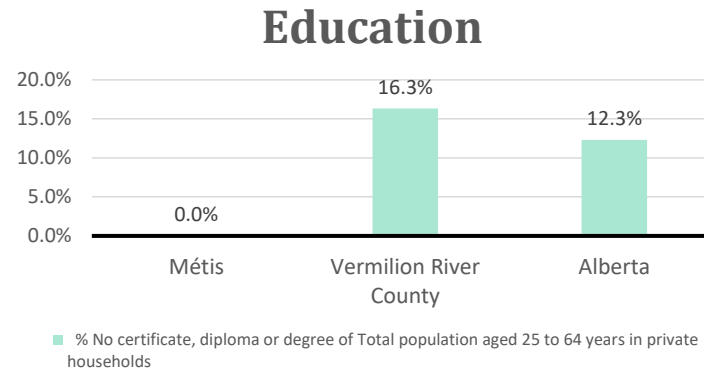
For Métis single identity population, the median age is 20.5 years old, with 76.9% of the population aged 15 and over. As for the total population, the median age is 38.4 in Vermilion River County and 36.1 years old in Alberta, with 77.8% and 81.0% population aged 15 and over respectively.

No Métis households reported moving in for the last year. 5 Métis households moved in the past 5 years (1.6%).



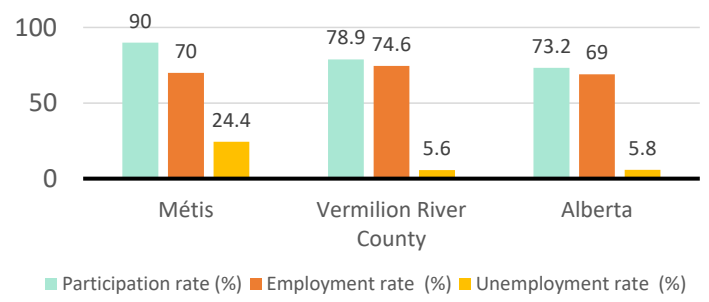
For population aged from 25 to 64 years, no Métis reported have no certificate, diploma or degree.

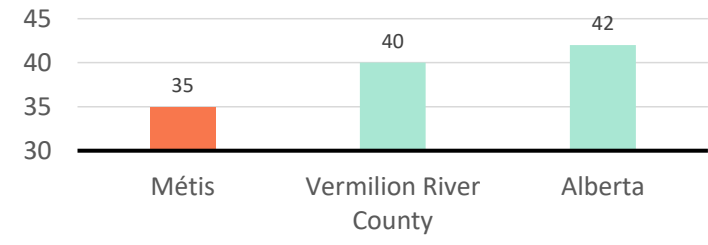
### Labour Force Status



Métis participation rate is 90.0%, employment rate is 70.0%, and unemployment rate is 24.4%.

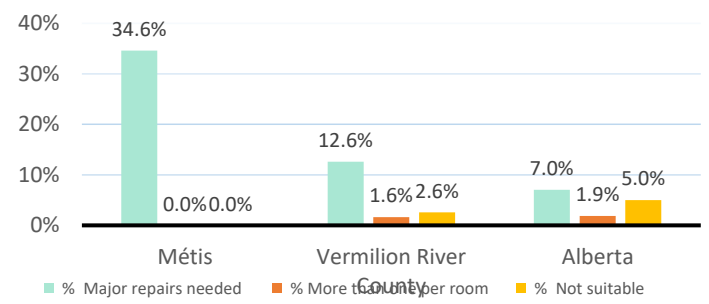
While the participation rate is higher compared with total population in Vermilion River County and Alberta (78.9% and 73.2%), unemployment rate is also higher.

### Average Weeks Worked in 2010



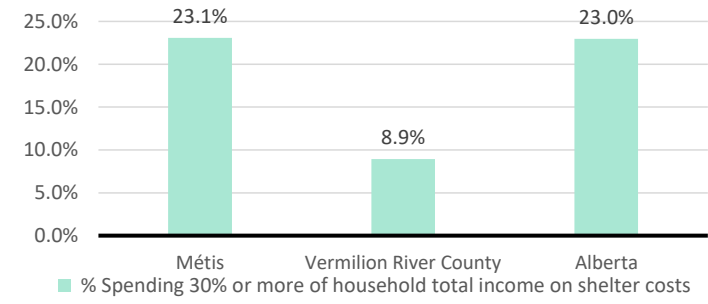
The average weeks worked in 2010 is 35.0 weeks.

### Household Characteristics



There are 130 private dwellings occupied by a Métis single household, out of which 34.6% need major repairs, no Métis household reported have more than one person per room, and no Métis household reported to be not suitable.

### Shelter Costs



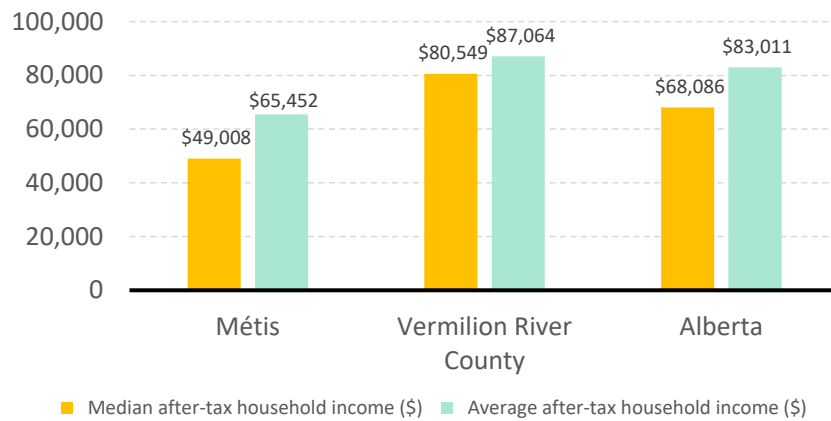
The number of Métis households spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs is 30, which is 23.1%

## Income

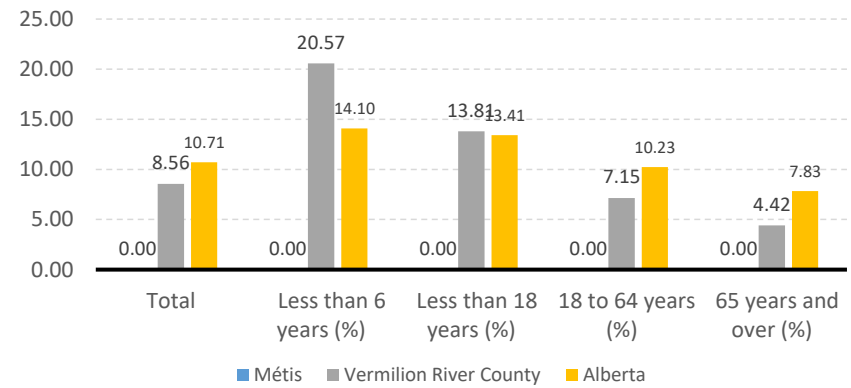
After-Tax Income of Households in 2010



For Métis singles, median after-tax household income is \$49,008, and average after-tax household income is
