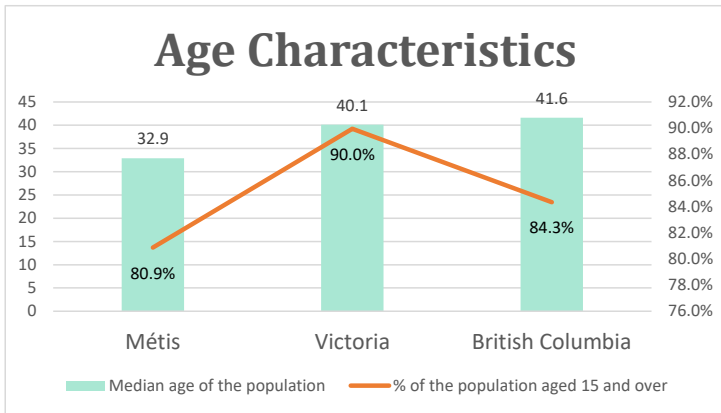

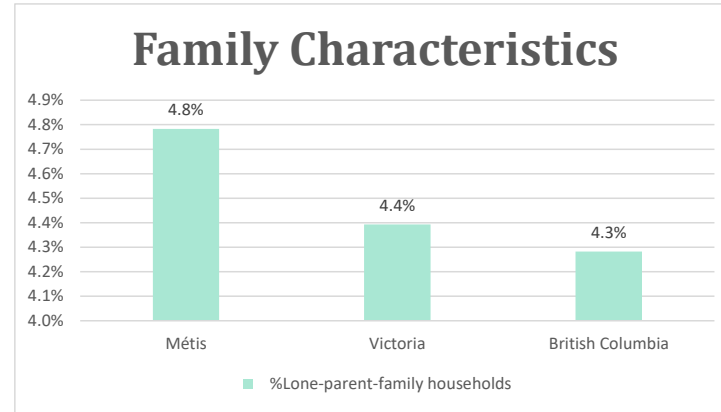

The total population reported with Métis single identity is 1,150 (Total Métis household is 810), representing 34% of Aboriginal people, accounting for 1.5% of the total population in Victoria.



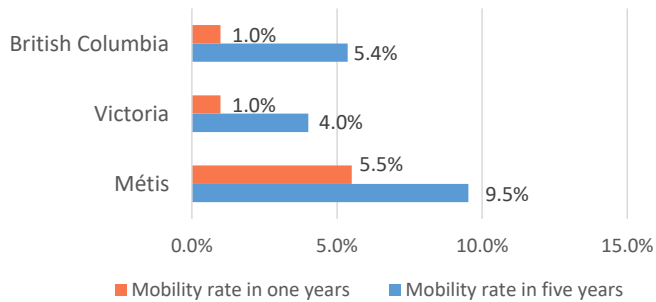
For Métis single identity population, the median age is 32.9 years old, with 80.9% of the population aged 15 and over. As for the total population, the median age is 40.1 in Victoria and

41.6 years old in British Columbia, with 90.0% and 84.3% population aged 15 and over respectively.



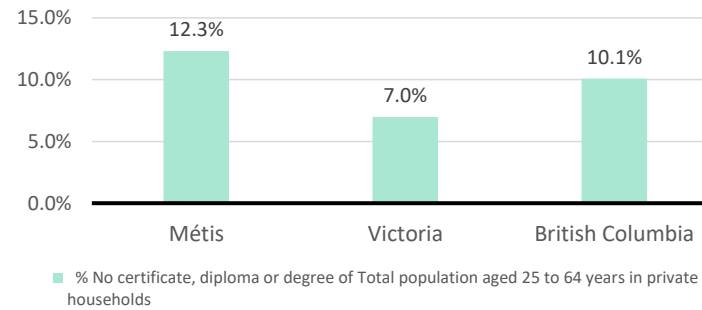
The number of Métis single lone parents household is 55, accounting for 4.8% of the total Métis single private households.

Education



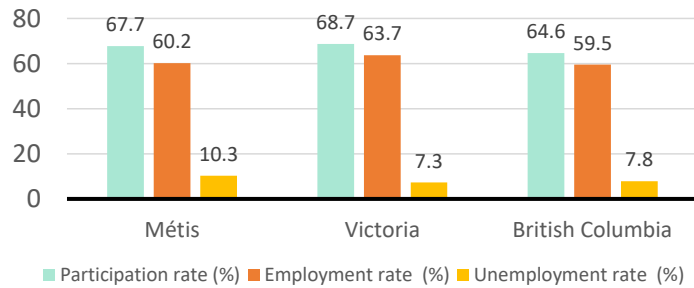
For population aged from 25 to 64 years, 12.3% Métis compared to 7.0% in Victoria and 10.1% in British Columbia have no certificate, diploma or degree.

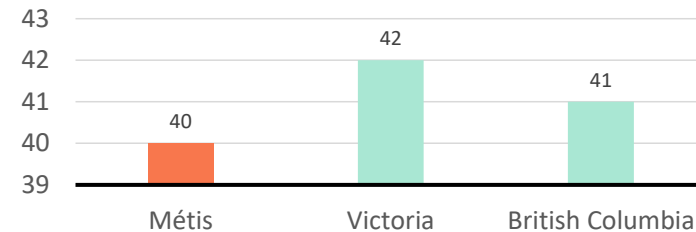
Labour Force Status



Métis participation rate is 67.7%, employment rate is 60.2%, and unemployment rate is 10.3%.

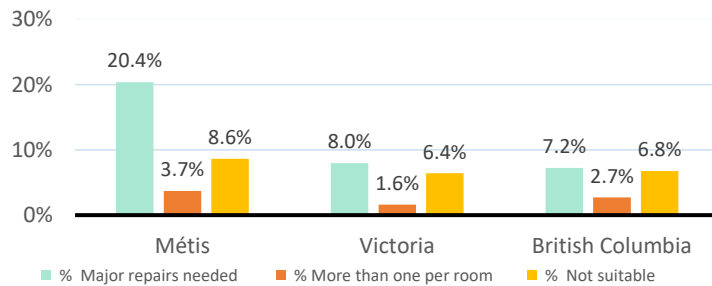
While the participation rate is lower compared with total population in Victoria and higher than British Columbia (68.7% and 64.6%), unemployment rate is higher.

Average Weeks Worked in 2010



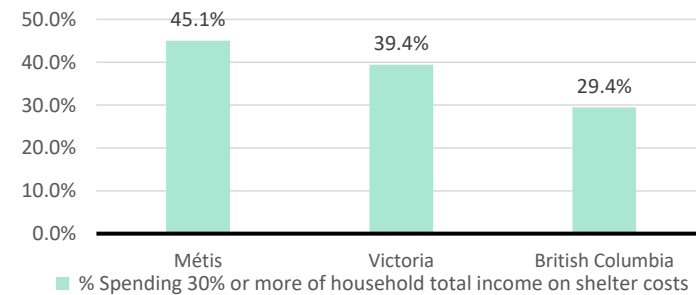
The average weeks worked in 2010 is 40.0 weeks.

Household Characteristics



There are 810 private dwellings occupied by a Métis single household, out of which 20.4% need major repairs, 3.7% have more than one person per room, and 8.6% Métis household reported to be not suitable.

Shelter Costs



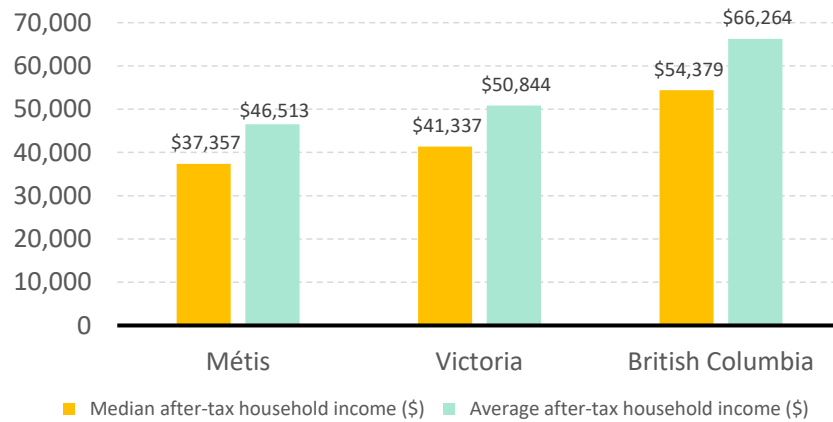
The number of Métis households spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs is 365, which is 45.1%

of the total private dwellings occupied by a Métis household, compared to 39.4% of the total population in Victoria and 29.4% of the total population in British Columbia.

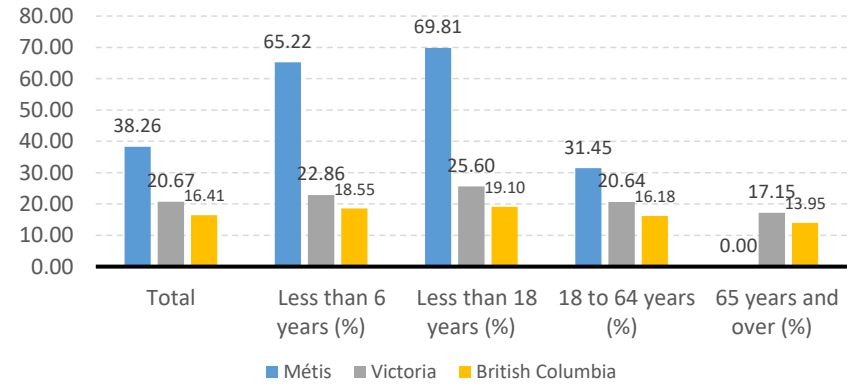
After-Tax Income of Households in 2010



For Métis singles, median after-tax household income is \$37,357, and average after-tax household income is

\$46,513. Métis has lower median and average after-tax income than Victoria and British Columbia.

Prevalence of Low Income in 2010 Based On After-Tax Low-Income Measure (%)



The prevalence of low income based on after-tax low-income measure is 38.26%.

The percentage of low income is 69.81% for people less than 18 years old, 65.22% for people less than 6 years old, 31.45% for people from 18 to 64 years old, and 0.00% for people over 65 years old.
