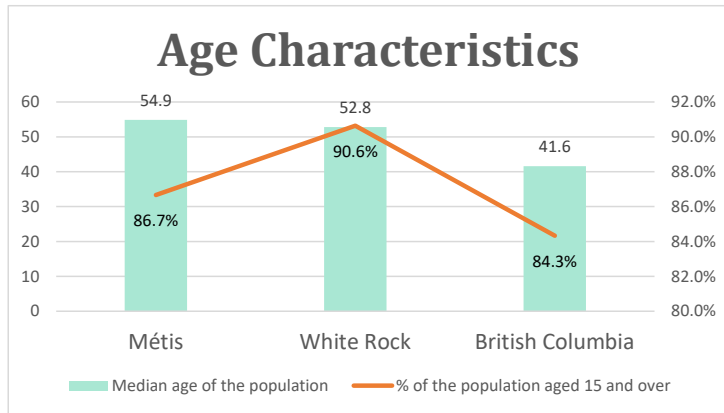

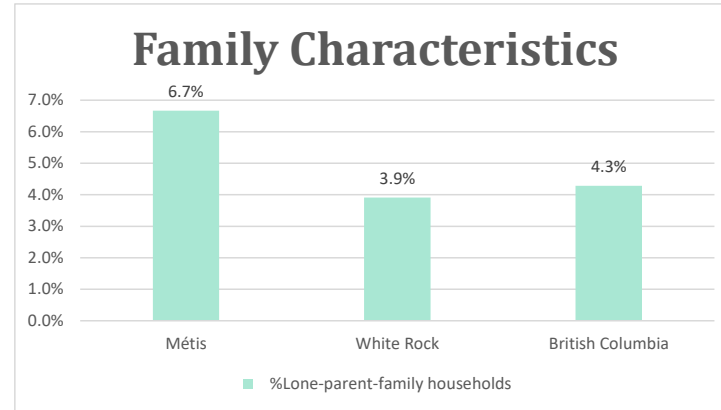

The total population reported with Métis single identity is 300 (Total Métis household is 180), representing 65% of Aboriginal people, accounting for 1.6% of the total population in White Rock.

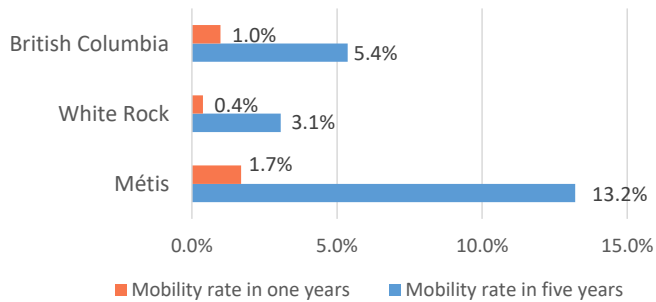


For Métis single identity population, the median age is 54.9 years old, with 86.7% of the population aged 15 and over. As for the total population, the median age is 52.8 in White Rock and 41.6 years old in British Columbia, with 90.6% and 84.3% population aged 15 and over respectively.



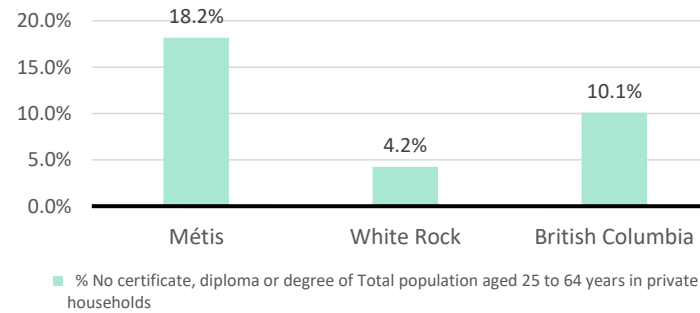
The number of Métis single lone parents household is 20, accounting for 6.7% of the total Métis single private households.

Education



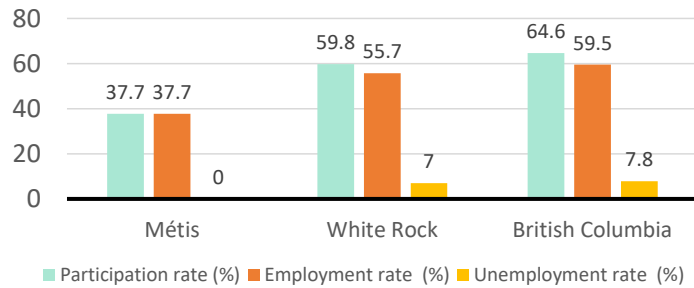

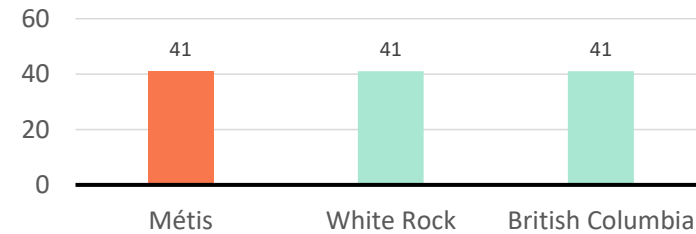
Labour Force Status



Métis participation rate is 37.7%, employment rate is 37.7%, and unemployment rate is 0.0%.

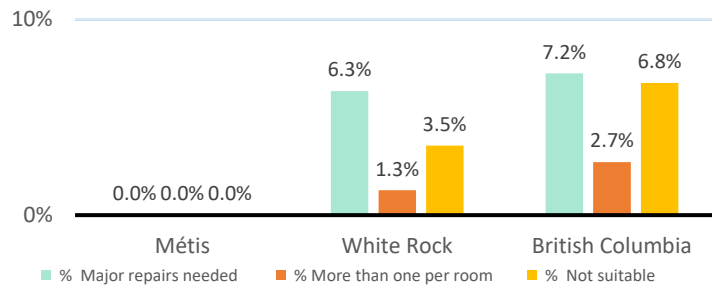
While the participation rate is lower compared with total population in White Rock and British Columbia (59.8% and 64.6%), no Métis reported unemployment.

Average Weeks Worked in 2010



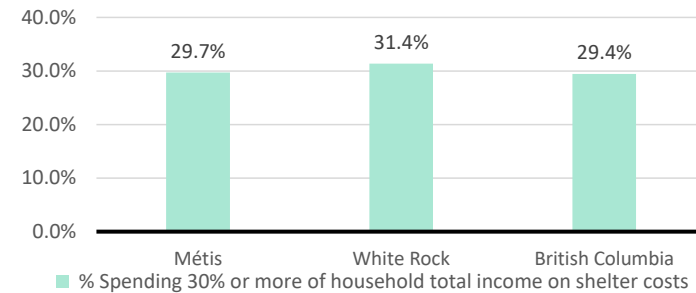
The average weeks worked in 2010 is 41.0 weeks.

Shelter Costs



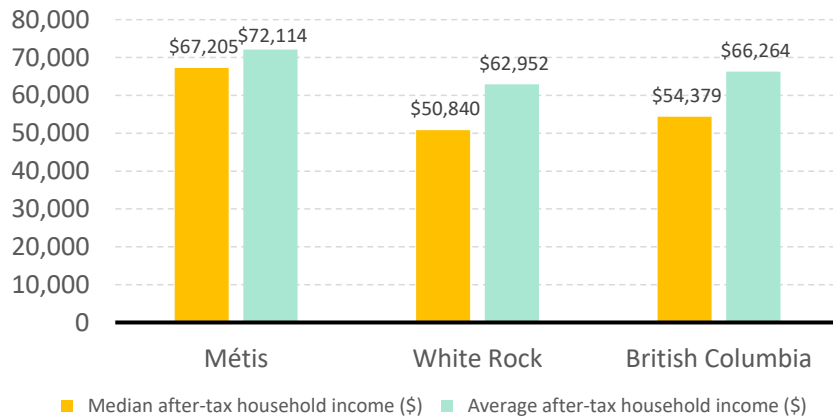
The number of Métis households spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs is 55, which is 29.7%

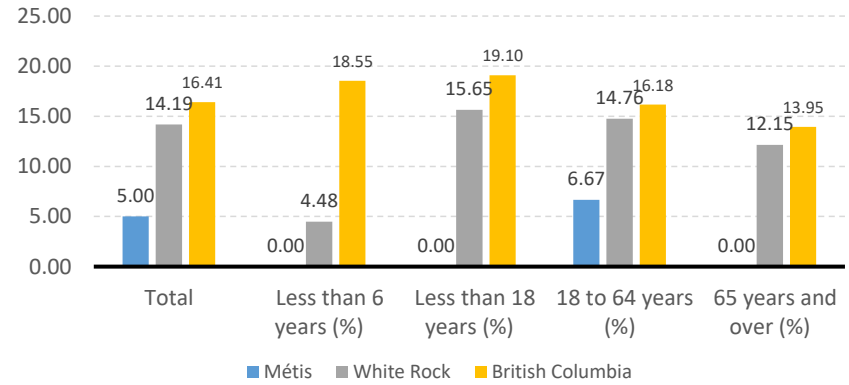
After-Tax Income of Households in 2010



For Métis singles, median after-tax household income is \$67,205, and average after-tax household income is

\$72,114. Métis has higher median and average after-tax income than White Rock and British Columbia.

Prevalence of Low Income in 2010 Based On After-Tax Low-Income Measure (%)



The prevalence of low income based on after-tax low-income measure is 5.00%.

The percentage of low income is 6.67% for people from 18 to 64 years old, and no Métis household reported low income in other age groups.
